

RAPTOR PROTOCOL

1. Scan all parents and visitors and even those that you know
2. Staff from other buildings, while wearing their Mayflower School District badge, are not required to be scanned by RAPTOR. A RAPTOR visitors badge is required if they do not have a District Badge. This is to assure all adults in the building can be identified.
3. If the ID is flagged as an offender and is a parent of a student and on that student's list, then follow the procedure below:
 - Level 1 and 2 have no restrictions as long as there will be another adult present with them at all times.
 - Level 3 and 4 are restricted to only being able to visit their child in the lobby. If they are here for a conference, they must wait in the lobby for the teacher.
4. If the ID is flagged and the person is persistent that it is a mistake, you may contact Officer Elliott, and he can run the license through the police department to be certain.
