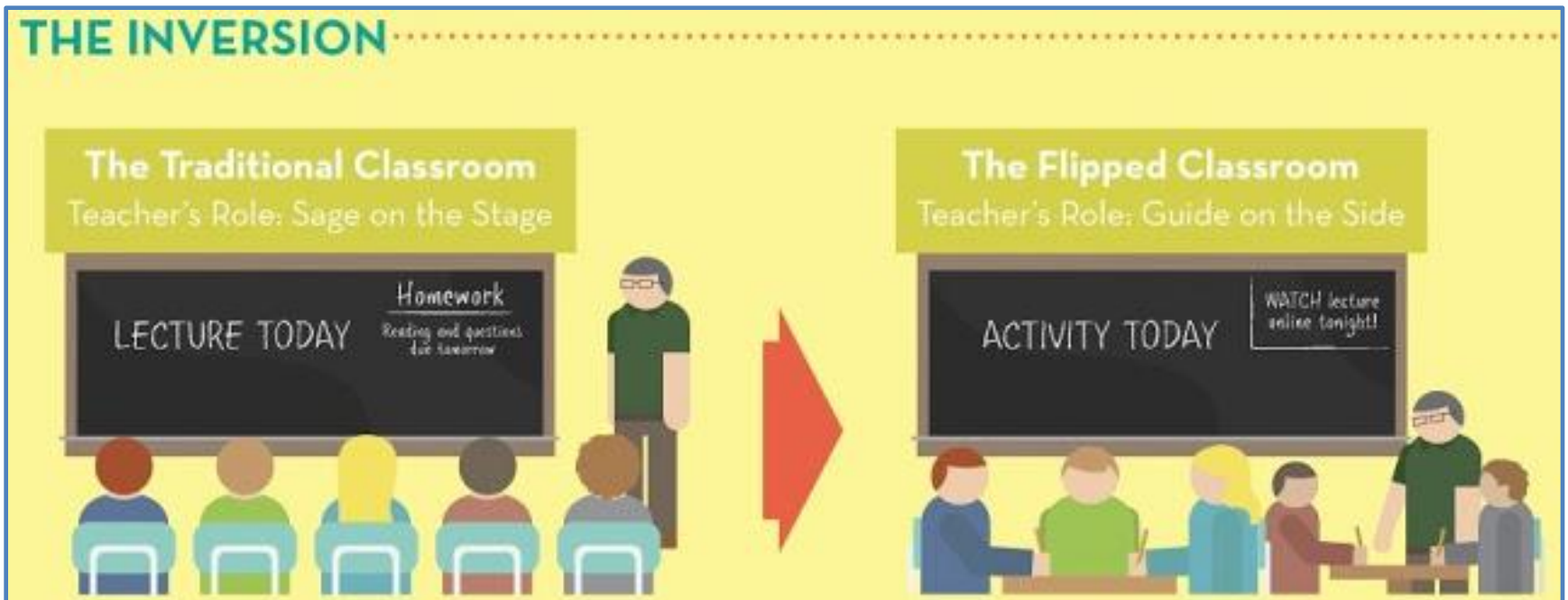
- Each table has one question to discuss.

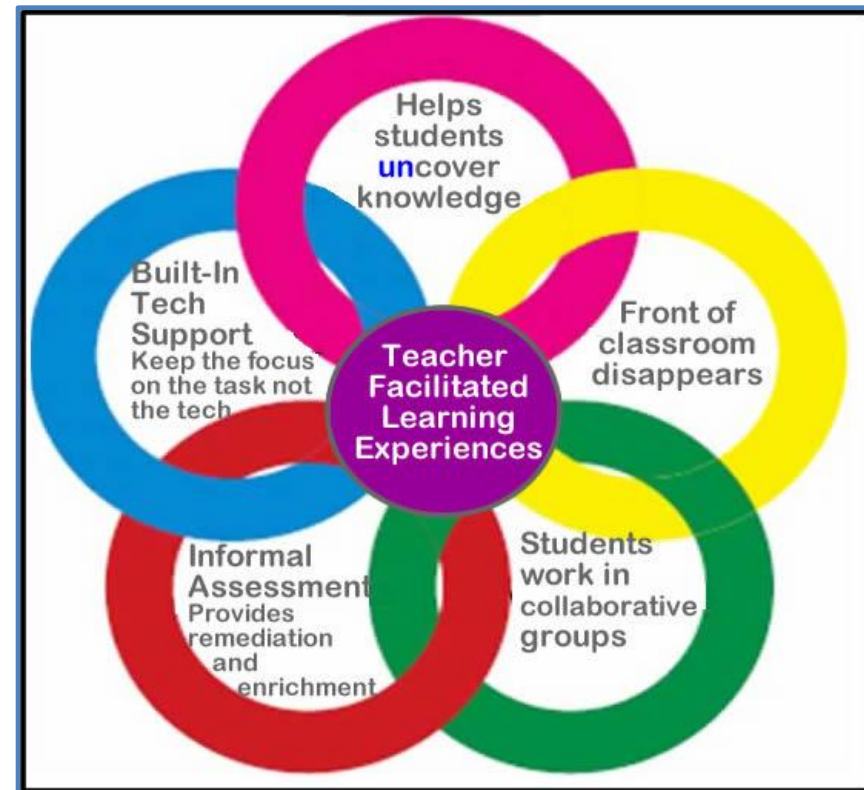
Positive School Culture of High Expectations and Grit

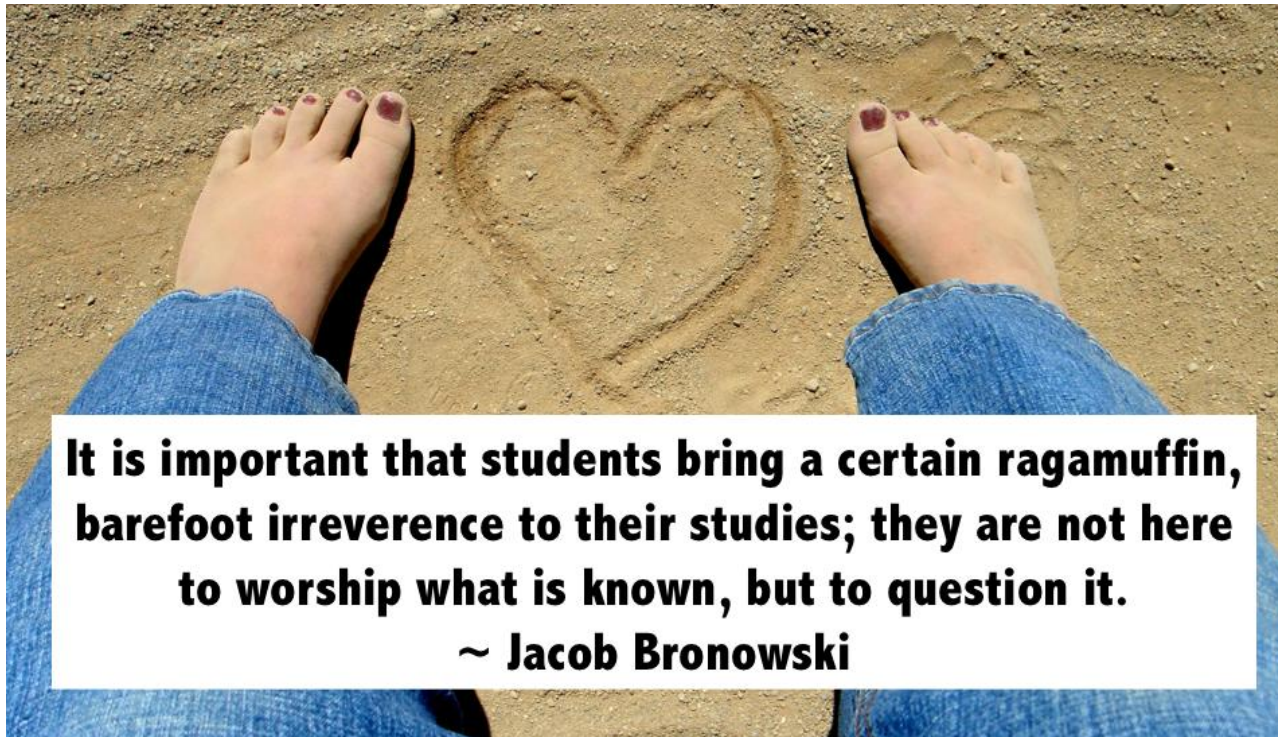
Positive Lesson Framing Techniques
