

Warren Transportation Department Accident Procedures and Policies

The Warren School District strives to provide the safest transportation possible for the students entrusted in our care. However occasionally situations arise that are beyond our measures of control and when such incidents occur we feel it is imperative to have a rigid set of policies and checks in place. The following are transportation policies to be in place in the event of an accident.

We ask that you do not show up at the scene of an accident involving your student. This only makes an already bad situation worse. Law enforcement, medical, and transportation personnel will be on scene in accordance to the severity of the situation. You **MAY NOT**, under any circumstances, remove your student from the scene of the accident until they are released by the proper authorities. This is mandated by state law. We must be able to have full accountability for each and every student on the bus.

Once the accident scene has been cleared, if your student has not been transported by ambulance, you will be able to sign your child out of the custody of school officials.

If your child is transported to the hospital you will be notified as soon as possible. We will inform you as which hospital and any other pertinent information regarding the details of the accident.
