Core Courses:

495350 Foundations of Health Care - Level 1: This course is designed to introduce students to medical professions and the basic foundational skills for first aid and the treatment of patients.

424030 Human Anatomy & Physiology - Level 2: This course helps students understand systems of the human body. It explores the inner workings of the human body. *This course can count as your 3rd year Science credit.***This course can be taken for college credit using 590680 course code, see your counselor.

1 Semester Course Electives:

You can complete **BOTH** courses below to count as 1 elective.

495370 Abnormal Psychology - Level 3: This course provides a basic overview of maladaptive human behavior.

495320 Human Behavior & Disorders Level 3: This course provides a general overview of psychology from the perspective of the health care community.

Electives:

495360 Medical Terms - Level 3: This course builds skills needed to form a foundation for using and understanding medical vocabulary.

**This course can be taken for college credit using 593260 course code, see your counselor.

495240 Medical Math - Level 3: This course is designed to increase students' ability to identify, solve, and apply mathematical principles as they relate to the health care system. **Medical Math is only offered on the even school years.**

495280 Pharmacy Tech - Level 3: This course introduces pharmacy practices and the technician's role in a variety of pharmacy settings. This class can not be taken as a Sophmore.

Pharmacy Tech is only offered on the odd school years.

590718 Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) - Level 3: This course provides instruction in the roles and responsibilities of the Nursing Assistant. This is a college class that prepares students to receive their CNA certification.
