



Knowledge, Skills, and Required Documents:

- ***Applicant must be 17 years of age or older***
- ***AR FTI members must be able to provide their own transportation***
- ***Preference given to those who have expressed interest in the field of education, nursing and/or commitment to service***
- ***Must be a high school graduate or have received the equivalence of a high school diploma***
- ***Driver's License or State ID***
- ***Birth Certificate***
- ***Social Security Card***
- ***Completed Application Packet***

AmeriCorps Program Benefits:

- Members receive a monthly living allowance.
- The living allowance is taxable and taxes will be deducted directly from the living allowance.
- Mileage reimbursement for service related training travel if funds are available.
- Education award for part-time member (900 hours) \$2,907.50 if successfully completed
- Experience in the field of education
- 48 hours of educational training

Criminal History Check:

Access to Vulnerable Populations: AR FTI members will have recurring access to vulnerable populations. The Arkansas Service Commission has determined that the probability of access to vulnerable populations is so great that all members will undergo all required criminal background checks:

- NSOPR (U.S. Department of Justice, National Sex Offender Public Website)
- FBI

- Arkansas State Police
- Any other states deemed necessary.
