

## Checking Student Grades from Power School in Evidence Based Learning (EBL)

We at USD #413 are thankful for parents who partner with us in educating Chanute children. We know that nothing is more important to parents than their children. You will find some visual changes as you visit the parent portal in Power School this year. In the past when you opened Power School to check up on your student's academic and behavioral progress your student's schedule, grades, and attendance would be visible immediately as a "Quick Lookup". At Royster Middle School this year we are piloting Evidence Based Learning and as such, academic and behavioral progress are now displayed in the standards tab.

When you log in to the parent portal on Power School look right under your student's name and there are two tabs: "**Quick Lookup**" which is the default and "**Standards Grades**".


For classes measuring learning in EBL, all at the Middle School and some at the High School, you will need to click on the "**Standards Grades**" tab. Now you can see measures of learning outcomes and where "clickable" may dig deeper into the descriptions of each.

While Royster Middle school is conducting a whole building pilot in EBL this year, Chanute High School is piloting in pockets. This is why you will see some grades under the "**Quick Lookup**" and some classes with the [i] symbol. These classes are not incomplete; they are being measured using the EBL pilot scales. When you see this in "**Quick Lookup**", maneuver up to the "**Standards Grades**" tab and you will see student measures from classes piloting EBL.

In the above example, the leadership class is measured with EBL and will require clicking on the "**Standards Grades**" tab. The Leadership Service in Action Class will look like an incomplete until the

user clicks the standards grades tab:



After clicking on the “**Standards Grades**” tab the user will see all of the student’s classes. Only those using EBL will be expandable with a click. Here is what a middle school grade might look like: Science World has not been expanded, Algebra 7 has been expanded.
