ELIGIBILITY:

The applicant must be a graduating senior of Chanute High School planning to continue his/her education at a college or university approved by the selection committee, majoring in a life science curriculum.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- GPA of at least 3.0
- Class Rank
- ACT Scores
- Course Content
- Extracurricular Activities
- Three Letters of Reference (i.e., science teacher, high school counselor, etc.)

ADMINISTRATION:

A selection committee will administer the Ashley Clinic Life Sciences Scholarship. Decision will be based upon the review of the selection criteria. **ALL of the Selection Criteria items listed above must be included with the application. Incomplete applications will not be considered for the award.** All decisions by the selection committee are final and incontestable.

Announcement of the scholarship recipient will be made during the annual Chanute High School Awards Banquet.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Applicant must complete the attached form in detail and return this to the Chanute High School Guidance Office by **March 26, 2021**. **ALL of the Selection Criteria items listed above must be included with the application. The application must have parent/guardian signature. Incomplete applications will not be considered for the award.** A personal interview with the Scholarship Committee may be requested.
