Additional Information:

1. This event is intended to give students the opportunity to perform in a competition setting where they are judged by music professionals who will give comments and feedback that will help them improve their musical ability.
2. Students performing in a solo/ensemble need to travel with the other students on the bus, watch Vocal Plus perform and then travel to McCray Hall and wait for their time to perform.
3. The students will eat lunch following the Mixed Ensemble performance. We will all eat at the McDonalds directly north of the University. They will be served a double cheeseburger, small fries and a soft drink courtesy of the school. If they desire any additional food, that will be up to them to pay for.
4. Clothing – Vocal Plus students will need to wear their tuxes or dresses. Non-Vocal Plus students need to wear very nice dress clothes.
5. Parents who want to pick their student up after they perform MUST sign out with Mr. Burnett. Please do not take your son/daughter without informing Mr. Burnett and signing the Student Sign Out Form. If someone other than a parent/guardian plans on taking a student (for example – an older brother) you must inform the school of this with a notarized letter sent to the office BEFORE April 22 (as per USD 413 policy).
6. Students must have all music memorized.
7. Parents and relatives are invited to come and watch their son/daughter perform! There is no cost. Keep in mind that these times are approximate – your son/daughter could perform a little earlier or a little later!
