

## COMSTOCK ISD EXPECTATIONS FOR PARENTS IN

### REMOTE LEARNING

1. Be a Learning Coach. Help your child to be successful!
2. Designate a learning space. Create an environment that encourages your child to develop a new learning style and gives them a desire to extend learning.
3. Develop a routine. Help create a balanced schedule, based on their class lesson plans and their individual needs at home.
4. Set expectations for your students.
5. Use the resources provided by CISD.
6. Be flexible with your children's struggles.
7. Celebrate your student's accomplishments.
8. Maintain communication with your child's teacher.

## COMSTOCK ISD EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS IN

### REMOTE LEARNING

1. Remote Learning will be as rigorous as face-to-face instruction. Students in Remote Learning are expected to make daily progress toward class goals.
2. Students that use fake names, inappropriate pictures, or are causing a disruption, will be removed from class and marked absent for the day.
3. All attendance rules are still in force. Excessive absences can cause a child to lose credit for a class. Student will have to make up the time or lose credit. Under the Transfer Contract, transfer students have additional attendance standards.
4. Students will only be allowed to change to/from Remote Instruction at the end/start of a grading period, unless there has been a mandated school closure.
5. Use the resources provided by CISD.

## COMSTOCK ISD EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS IN SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING

1. Students will attend class on time - per their class schedule.
2. Student will follow CISD dress code.
3. Students are ready to learn when class begins.
4. A workspace is designated for the student.
5. Students will show their face on the screen to engage with the teacher virtually.
6. Students will participate in the class. The CISD Handbook and Code of Conduct will be in effect.

## COMSTOCK ISD EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS IN ASYNCHRONOUS LEARNING

1. Complete asynchronous activities assigned each day.
2. Students must show proof of participation in daily remote learning by satisfactorily completing assigned assignments to demonstrate evidence of student learning *ie. video, picture, or activities submitted as lessons and/or completing assignments. Please note, not all lessons will have an assignment, as there will be teacher discretion on the number of assignments, as they follow the CISD grading guidelines.*
3. Students and parents will communicate with the teacher when needing additional assistance, tutoring, etc.
