Students can make up work, but I cannot replace the instruction they would have received if they had been present. There is a direct relationship between a child's attendance and their performance. That being said, if your child is sick and running a fever, please do not send them to school. This makes others ill...and a child who doesn't feel well is not going to be able to focus on instruction, anyway. Please try to schedule dental and other well-child appointments for Mondays.
