Join the slow roll!

Saskatoon Cycles will be leading a slow roll throughout our festival site, following this exact path. Everyone is welcome to join in on the Saskatoon Cycles slow roll!

To join the slow roll, meet up with the Saskatoon Cycles crew underneath the Broadway Bridge (on the Downtown side) at 7:00 PM to set up your bikes. After a brief festival and safety overview the slow roll will start promptly at 7:15.

Consider lighting up your bike to become a part of Saskatoon's most illuminating festival!

Bike back down towards the river on 3rd. Circle under the Traffic Bridge and head down River Landing towards the Idylwyld Bridge

Travel up to the Remai Modern. There are four more NBYXE projects left to see Downtown. This might be a good time to get off your bike, lock them up, and tour inside projects.

Hop back on your bikes and travel down the Traffic Bridge towards the other side of the river. The bridge will be closed to vehicle traffic. When you're at the end of the bridge, turn left and bike up Saskatchewan Crescent, finally turning right on Eastlake Avenue.

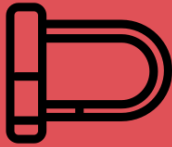
Tips for Enjoying Your Evening:
