



Linden Park is Nationally Recognized with a Special Recognition for American Institute of Architect's Design for Aging Review Award



Linden Park Apartments, a 266 unit community for residents 62 & over, was awarded Special Recognition for the 14th Edition of the American Institute of Architects (AIA) Design for Aging Review Awards. Each year the AIA Design for Aging Knowledge Community invites architects, designers and providers to submit projects that represent conscientious design that advances environments for senior living to the jury for review. The selected winners are then highlighted in a juried exhibition and book that become a reference for senior housing providers, developers, advocates, architects, interior designers and other design professionals.

The jury selected Linden Park with a Special Recognition award due to the transformation of the 1960's highrise building in Baltimore and the creation of space for outside service partners to provide on-site services to the community's residents. The jury highlighted how Linden Park's redevelopment improves the lives of the residents, allows them the opportunity to age in place and brings an overall renewal to the neighborhood. The award highlighted Linden Park's redevelopment team of Wiencek + Associates, Architects + Planners and Somerset Memorial Partners.
