Over 20 years experience as an Infectious Diseases Clinician, including managing diverse and complex patients routinely.

Key Accomplishments

- Leader of Antibiotic Stewardship and Diagnostic Stewardship program, resulting in system-wide adoption of a *C. diff* diagnostic testing algorithm, with a reduction of hospital acquired *C. diff* incidence.
- As a physician leader, spearheaded efforts to bring in house rapid diagnostic tests to help increase the utilization of point of care diagnosis. This included procalcitonin, multiplex respiratory pathogen testing, and rapid MRSA screening, and involved routine collaboration with other professionals, creating alliances to foster implementation of process improvement programs.
- Educator to medical staff and hospital administration on implementation of best practices, including reduction of Hospital Acquired Infections, development of clinical pathways consistent with evidence based medicine, and initiation of pharmacy driven penicillin skin testing with outreach to stakeholders across multiple disciplines.
