A neurologist surgeon for more than 20 years, Dr. Moore is an established specialist in neck, laser spine and brain tumor surgery in South Florida. He is the only CyberKnife-trained neurosurgeon in Broward County and frequently can offer this cutting-edge treatment over traditional operations. Dr. Moore treats many patients with pituitary tumors and performs the most surgeries in Broward County using the intraoperative Stealth Navigation system for best outcomes.

An honors graduate of Harvard College, Moore attended Yale Medical School, where he received an award for his thesis in neuroregeneration studies. He completed his residency at Harvard Medical School's Brigham & Women's Hospital, where he was chief resident and a Harvey Cushing Fellow.

Moore has expertise in a variety of benign and malignant brain and spine tumors. He also commonly performs the latest microscopic surgeries for neck and lower back pain caused by herniated discs and arthritis. Moore is the Medical Director of the Spine Care Center, which is the FIRST Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO) certified spine center in all of South Florida (that is Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties). JCAHO performs the most rigorous and comprehensive of all federal inspections.

For more than 10 years, the private practice group to which Dr. Moore belongs were team physicians for the Miami Dolphins and now for the local NHL Players' Association. The group, Neurological Surgery Associates, has two convenient offices in Lighthouse Point and West Broward County, Tamarac. Dr. Moore accepts most kinds of insurance and also frequently provides expert witness testimony and IME's for accident cases throughout Florida.
