(1) Of the 3,848,076 shares reported on this Schedule 13D (a) 3,166,132 shares are held by YKA Partners, L.P. ("YKA"), (b) 681,944 shares are owned of record by SeaCrest Partners I, L.P. ("SeaCrest"), and (c) 106,000 are owned of record by Kenneth C. Aldrich ("Mr. Aldrich"). Mr. Aldrich is the investment manager of YKA and has sole voting and dispositive power over these shares. Mr. Aldrich, together with William B. Adams, the Chief Financial Officer of BTHC III, Inc. (the "Issuer"), are the general partners of SeaCrest and have equally shared voting and dispositive power over the shares held by SeaCrest.

Item 1. Security and Issuer

The class of securities to which this statement relates is common stock, par value \$0.001 per share (the "BTHC Common Stock"), of the Issuer, and the principal executive offices of the Issuer are located at 2595 Jason Court, Oceanside, CA 92056.

Item 2. Identity and Background

The identity and background of the person filing this statement and the person enumerated in Instruction C to 13D is as follows:

Mr. Aldrich is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Issuer, which is his principal occupation. The principal business address for Mr. Aldrich is 2595 Jason Court, Oceanside, CA 92056. Mr. Aldrich is also the Managing Director of Convergent Ventures, an early-stage life sciences investment company, a general partner of SeaCreast and the investment manager for YKA. The principal business address of Convergent Ventures is 157 Surfview Drive, Pacific Palisades, CA 90272. Mr. Aldrich is a citizen of the United States.

During the last five years, Mr. Aldrich has not been (i) convicted in a criminal proceeding (excluding traffic violations and similar misdemeanors) or (ii) a party to a civil proceeding or a judicial or administrative body of competent jurisdiction and as a result of such proceeding, was or is subject to a judgment, decree or final order enjoining future violations of, or prohibiting or mandating activities subject to, federal or state securities laws or finding any violation with respect to such laws.

Item 3. Source and Amount of Funds or Other Consideration

Prior to the transactions reported on this form, Mr. Aldrich had sole and dispositive power over (a) 3,166,132 shares held by YKA, (b) 681,944 shares owned of record by SeaCrest and (c) 106,000 owned of record by himself of International Stem Cell Corporation, a California corporation ("International Stem Cell") common stock ("ISC Common Stock"). Pursuant to a share exchange (the "Share Exchange") consummated on December 28, 2006, each share of ISC Common Stock was exchanged for one share of BTHC Common Stock. In connection with the Share Exchange, Mr. Aldrich was elected to the Board of Directors of the Issuer.

Item 4. Purpose of Transaction

See Item 3 above. Mr. Aldrich holds the shares of BTHC Common Stock referenced herein for general investment purposes. Mr. Aldrich may purchase additional shares of BTHC Common Stock in private or open-market transactions for investment purposes, or dispose of shares of BTHC Common Stock. Mr. Aldrich does not, in his capacity as an investor in securities of the Issuer, have a plan or proposal with respect to any of the matters set forth in paragraphs (a) through (j) of Item 4 of this statement.

Item 5. Interest in Securities of the Issuer

- (a) The responses of Mr. Aldrich with respect to Rows 11, 12 and 13 of the cover pages of this Schedule 13D that relate to the aggregate number and percentage of BTHC Common Stock (including but not limited to footnote (1) to such information) are incorporated herein by reference. The figures repeated in Row 13 of the cover pages are based upon 35,321,495 shares, as reported in the Current Report on Form 8-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission by the Issuer on December 29, 2006.
- (b) The responses of Mr. Aldrich with respect to Rows 7, 8, 9 and 10 of the cover pages of this Schedule 13D that relate to the number of shares as to which Mr. Aldrich has sole power to vote or to direct the vote, shared power to vote or to direct the vote and sole or shared power to dispose or to direct the disposition (including but not limited to footnote (1) to such information) are incorporated herein by reference.
- (c) Except as described in this Schedule 13D, during the past 60 days there have been no other transactions in the securities of the Issuer effected by Mr. Aldrich.
