

He gave a presentation describing the pros and cons of inverter versus conventional welding power sources. He then demoed a Miller Dynasty 280 and a Millermatic 350P. The result is that inverters are more expensive but put out a wide variety of welding current and voltage options, including pulsed welding, using less power.
