## What Does Amended OP&P10 Change?

Effective only once the DURSA is amended, since existing OP&P 10 would no longer be needed to provide authority to pilot Carequality connectivity, revised OP&P 10 **defines the process** by which Participants opt-out of participation in Coordinating Committee-authorized data sharing network agreements.

### Highlights:

- eHealth Exchange staff will notify Participants when the Coordinating Committee enters into new network data sharing agreements and will share flow-down provisions
- Participants have 60 days to opt-out
- The Executive Director will review opt-out notices with the Coordinating Committee
