



Alabama CPA Continuing Education Requirements

Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- Minimum 20 hours per year
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of board approved ethics CPE for every 2 year renewal period. General ethics is not acceptable.
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%

CPE Completion Due by: 9/30 each year and must be reported by 10/1

Acceptable Programs of Study: The code reads as follows: "the overriding consideration in determining whether a specific program qualifies as acceptable continuing professional education is that it be a formal program of learning which contributes directly to the professional competence of the person who is required to meet the Board's CPE requirements. It is left up to each individual to determine the course of study to be pursued, provided that the course of study meets all applicable Alabama CPE requirements. For example, the individual in public practice may study accounting and auditing, tax, or other topics concerning their practice; individuals in government may study government related topics; and individuals in business or industry may study topics related directly to their specific business or industry."
