



Alaska CPA Continuing Education Requirements

Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- Minimum 20 hours per year
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of ethics CPE for every 2 year renewal period. General ethics is not acceptable.
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%
