



Arizona CPA Continuing Education Requirements

Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- At least 50% of those hours shall be in the areas of accounting, auditing, taxation, business law, or management advisory services
- A minimum of 16 hours must be in the subjects areas of accounting/auditing or taxation
- A maximum of 20 CPE hours allowed in Introductory Computer courses
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of Arizona state-specific ethics during the period immediately preceding each biennial registration renewal
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 80% (64 hours)

- Registrants born in even numbered years shall register during the month of their birth date in each even numbered year.
- Registrants born in odd numbered years shall register during the month of their birth date in each odd numbered year.
