



Arkansas CPA Continuing Education Requirements

Required Education

- 120 hours within the 36 months or 40 hours within the 12 months immediately preceding the renewal date of application.
- 60% of the hours must be in accounting, accounting ethics, attest, taxation, computer science or management advisory services.
- License holders engaged in attest or compilation function, shall complete at least 20% in subject areas of attest and accounting theory and practice.
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of accounting professional conduct and ethics CPE during any 36 month reporting period.
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 60%
