



Colorado CPA Continuing Education Requirements

Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- Maximum 16 hours of Personal Development
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of ethics CPE every 2 years, with no more than 2 hours of CR&R. NOTE: New licensees are required to complete a CR&R course within 6 months of initial licensure.
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%
