



## Connecticut CPA Continuing Education Requirements

### Required Education

- 40 hours of CPE annually
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of ethics CPE every 3 years.
- 8 hours in the subject area of attest or compilation services for licensees who perform or supervise attest or compilation services and who sign or authorize another to sign reports on financial statements
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%

**License Expiration:** Registrants must register annually by 12/31

**CPE Completion Due by:** 6/30 of license expiration year. CPE reporting period runs 7/1 to 6/30.

**Acceptable Programs of Study:** Connecticut CPE requirements state: "the overriding consideration in determining whether a specific program qualifies as acceptable continuing education is that it be a formal program of learning which contributes directly to the professional competence of an individual licensed to practice public accounting" and "the responsibility for substantiating that a particular program is acceptable and meets the requirements rests solely upon the applicant".
