Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- Minimum 40 hours per year
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of ethics CPE each reporting period.
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%

- Specific areas designated: accounting and auditing, taxation, management advisory services, computer science, communication arts, mathematics, economics, business law, ethics, functional fields of business, specialized areas of industry and administrative practice.
