Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- Minimum 8 hours in accounting and/or auditing
- Minimum of 8 hours in taxation
- 4 hours in a Board approved Delaware Ethics course every 2 years
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 24 hours
