### Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- Minimum 20 hours per year
- Minimum of 16 hours in Accounting and Auditing
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%

**License Expiration:** Registrants must register biennially by 12/31 of every odd year

**CPE Completion Due by:** 12/31 of license expiration year

**Acceptable Programs of Study:** Georgia CPE requirements list of acceptable programs include: Accounting, Auditing, Taxation, Management Service, Computer Science, Oral and written communications, Mathematics, Statistics, Economics, Business Law, Functional Fields of Business, Specialized Areas of Industry, Administrative of an accounting practice.

Areas other than those listed above may be acceptable if the registrant can demonstrate that they contribute to the registrant's professional competence. The responsibility for substantiating that a particular program is acceptable and meets the requirements rests solely upon the registrant.
