



Louisiana CPA Continuing Education Requirements

Required Education

- 120 hours of CPE every 3 years
- Maximum of 25% (30 hours) in Personal Development courses
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of board-approved ethics CPE each renewal period
- Certificate holders who participate in attest engagements must completed at least 20% (24 hours) in Accounting and Auditing
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%
