Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- Minimum of 40 hours per year
- Minimum 8 hours in Accounting and Auditing each year
- Ethics Requirement: 2 hours of ethics CPE each year
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 20 hours per year
