Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- Minimum of 20 hours per year
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of ethics CPE each renewal period
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%

CPE Completion Due by: 12/31 and reported by 1/31. You must show 80 hours of CPE completed in the two-year period prior to renewal each year.

Acceptable Programs of Study: Nevada CPE requirements state: Courses qualify as long as they "adhere to the standards established by NASBA" and they "contribute to a growth in professional knowledge and the competence of a person engaged in the practice of public accounting." The board has no formal sponsor registration requirements.
