



North Dakota CPA Continuing Education Requirements

Required Education

- 120 hours of CPE every 3 years, with a minimum 20 hours per year, if engaged in public accounting **OR**
- 60 hours of CPE every 3 years, with a minimum 16 hours per year, if not engaged in public accounting
- Ethics Requirement: None; although ethics courses are encouraged
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 100%
