



Vermont CPA Continuing Education Requirements

Required Education

- 80 hours of CPE every 2 years
- 40 hours per year is recommended but not required
- Minimum of 8 hours in Accounting and Auditing
- Ethics Requirement: 4 hours of ethics CPE each renewal period
- Maximum Self-Study Allowed: 80% (64 hours)
