Mortgage Lifter (Radiator Charlie's)	WV, Heirloom	beefsteak	85	A mechanic (Radiator Charlie) bred this variety in the 1940s and paid off his mortgage by selling his seedlings. Meaty and truly delicious. Few seeds. Ark of Taste winner .
Pink Brandywine	Heirloom	beefsteak	82	Classic heirloom from 1885. Up to 1½ lbs. This "Quisenberry/Sudduth" strain is among the best. Potato leaf.
Pruden's Purple	Heirloom	beefsteak	72	Early for its size. Silky texture, few seeds, balanced. True tomato taste. Disease resistant, potato leaf variety.
Rose de Berne	Switzerland, Heirloom	slicer	80	Flavorful and sweet! No cracks or blemishes. Late blight tolerance. One of Mindy's absolute favorites!
Soldacki	Poland, Heirloom	beefsteak	75	Sweet, rich flavor. Perfect for sandwiches. Can crack in wet seasons but worth its amazing flavor. Potato Leaf.

Cuostralee	France, Heirloom	beefsteak	85	Worth the wait! Huge 1-2 lb. meaty fruit w/few seeds. Great yields for a beefsteak. A Mindy favorite! Classic flavor.

Jet Star	Hybrid, Semi-Determinate	slicer	72	Heavy yields, beautiful red color, no cracks, and reliable. Best early, full size tomato in trials. Disease resistant.

Sioux	Heirloom	slicer	70	Sets in hot weather. Perfect sweet-tart flavor. Released by the Univ. of Nebraska in 1944. Smooth fruit, no blemishes.
Stupice	Czech, Heirloom	small salad	52	Extra early, compact plant. Small and tasty tomatoes borne in clusters. Egg shaped and sized. Potato leaf.
Sugar Gem	Heirloom	small salad	71	With light gold sparkles in the red skin, these tall and vigorous plants yield huge crops of golf ball sized meaty, juicy tomatoes that have a small core and delicious sweet, well-balanced flavors. Great for snacking.

Pink Passion *	OP	pink, slicer	67	These compact high-yielding plants produce beautiful heart-shaped, rose-colored fruits; rich, fruity with small seed cavity.
Pink Berkeley Tie Dye *	OP	pink marbled, beefsteak	75	Compact plants produce stunning 8-12 oz port wine colored fruits with metallic green stripes, sweet, dark, and rich in flavor.
Purple Heart *	OP	purple, slicer	67	This rich, full-flavored variety is prolific and beautiful, sporting an adorable heart-shaped fruit. Similar in flavor to Cherokee Purple and Paul Robeson.
