<b>Pruden's Purple</b>	Heirloom	beefsteak	72	Early for its size. Silky texture, few seeds, balanced. True tomato taste. Disease resistant, potato leaf variety.
<b>Rose de Berne</b>	Switzerland, Heirloom	slicer	80	Flavorful and sweet! No cracks or blemishes. Late blight tolerance. One of Mindy's absolute favorites!

<b>Buffalo Heart</b>	Poland, Heirloom	large slicer	75	Large high-yielding plants produce pale rosy-pink to red heart-shaped fruits with firm flesh and are packed with great flavor. Rare seed.
<b>Bush Beefsteak *</b>	OP, <b>Determinate</b>	beefsteak	62	A fantastic early-season variety, compact and prolific, that produces huge 8-10 oz beefsteak tomatoes in clusters. Excellent for regions with shorter growing seasons.
<b>Cosmonaut Volkov</b>	Ukraine, Heirloom	slicer	65	Great early tomato! Named for a Russian space explorer. We love its dependable, delicious production. Cold tolerant and hands down one of the most flavorful tomatoes!
<b>Costoluto Genovese</b>	Italy, Heirloom	ribbed	78	A favorite Italian tomato with beautiful ribbed fruits. Delicious for stuffing or sauce; perfect w/basil & mozzarella.

<b>Italian Giant</b>	Heirloom	beefsteak	85	Brought over from Italy more than 80 years ago. Productive yield of 1 lb. fruits that are flavorful and meaty. Excellent for salads, sandwiches and Italian dishes.
<b>Jet Star</b>	Hybrid, <b>Semi-Determinate</b>	slicer	72	Heavy yields, beautiful red color, no cracks, and reliable. Best early, full size tomato in trials. Disease resistant.
<b>Large Red</b>	Heirloom	beefsteak	85	Prior to the Civil War (yes, I said Civil War), Large Red was one of the most prized varieties in the U.S. Generous amounts of 1-2 lb., heavily ribbed, flattened fruits that shout out terrific, complex, well-balanced, sweet flavors with that old-fashioned acidic "tang" that makes it a winner.

<b>Juliet</b>	Hybrid	plum, small	60	A staff fave for salads, canning, drying & roasting. Firm clusters hold on the vine w/out cracking. Disease resistant.
<b>Principe Borghese *</b>	Italy, Heirloom <b>Determinate</b>	grape, small	75	Famous for sun drying; this small 1-2 oz grape-shaped fruits grow abundantly in clusters.
<b>Roma *</b>	OP, <b>Determinate</b>	plum	76	Quality paste tomato with thick flesh and great yields.
<b>San Marzano</b>	Italy, Heirloom	plum	80	Classic paste tomato from Italy with delicious sweet flavor.
