

Welcome to Devon Point Farm Camp!

Welcome to farm camp! It's hard to believe that we are just a few weeks away from the start of Farm Camp at Devon Point Farm! From planting seeds to helping with barnyard chores your children will be immersed in a week filled with farm exploration and fun activities!

We are busy getting the farm ready to greet the campers and making sure all of our paperwork is done in advance of camp starting.

This packet includes TWO FORMS WHICH NEED TO BE FILLED OUT, SIGNED AND RETURNED BY THE 1st DAY of CAMP:

- 1) Per the State of CT, we are required to have a HEALTH FORM completed by your child's physician within 36 months of the start of camp. Health forms will be kept confidential and in a secure file. You can make a copy of the form that you use for school as long as it shows your child's vaccination history, allergies, medication, and special needs, **OR** you can have them fill out and sign the enclosed "Health Exam/Record" form.
- 2) Per the State of CT, we are required to have a PERMISSION & RELEASE FORM for sunscreen, insect repellent and who is allowed to pick up your child (enclosed).

Please note: Devon Point Farm Camp staff are not allowed to administer medications. If you have any questions regarding our policy, please contact Devon Point Farm at 860-974-9004.

Our week is set-up so each group will be introduced to the importance of sustainable agriculture which is appropriate to each age level. Our mornings will begin with welcoming each new day to the farm by feeding the animals in the barnyard. We have great farm stories written by wonderful authors to share with your children during the day and a very long list of crafts, games and songs to keep them entertained all day long!

We do want to ensure that everyone is prepared for camp. Included with this letter is a checklist of things that we ask you to send with your camper each day and a few things that should be left at home during camp.

We hope you and your children are excited about camp as much as we are at Devon Point Farm! We have had a wonderful time planning and can't wait to meet all the campers!!!!

The big white barn will be the meeting place for campers each morning. Get ready for a FARMTASTIC week!!!!
