



DEVON POINT FARM CAMP

CHECKLIST OF WHAT TO BRING & HELPFUL TIPS

Camp will be held rain or shine and we will be outside some of the time in the rain as long as there is no thunder or lightening. We do ask that children come to camp dressed appropriately for the weather... dress them in layers as the temperature changes from morning to afternoon.

Most of the farm day will be spent out and about around the farm. The days are planned so indoor time or time in the shade is used for the very hot sunny parts of the day. We do not have swimming but we will have water fun games and a sprinkler. Feel free to send a swim suit and towel.

WHAT TO BRING:

NOTE: EVERYTHING SHOULD BE LABELED WITH THE CAMPER'S NAME!

- Weather-appropriate clothing
- Sturdy sneakers, shoes or crocs (no open-toed shoes allowed)
- Rain boots
- Rain coat
- Hat that has a brim and is well ventilated
- An ENTIRE CHANGE OF CLOTHES! (bagged and labeled... farming can be dirty!)
- Optional: swimsuit and towel for running through sprinkler on hot days
- Two (2) Water Bottles (labeled with your child's name)
- Lunch and two (2) snacks (note: We are not a peanut-free camp!)
We have a cooler to keep lunches & water bottles cold.
- Sun Block: Please apply before dropping your child off.
ALL SUN BLOCK MUST BE LABELED and given to Farm Camp Counselors. (see release form)
- Bug Spray: Please supply bug spray (labeled) if you want bug spray used at camp.
(See release form)

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED:

- NO OPENED TOE SHOES OR FLIP FLOPS ALLOWED
- NO ELECTRONICS (iPods, games etc...). We will have plenty to keep us entertained and do not want anything broken at camp.
- NO TOYS. All toys should be left at home. We do not want any hurt feelings if a special toy breaks or goes missing

SPECIAL NOTES:

- MEDICATION: If your child takes a medication please give this prior to sending to camp. Children with inhalers must be old enough to use them on their own. Devon Point Farm Camp staff are not allowed to administer medications. Please contact Devon Point Farm at 860-974-9004 for all questions related to medication.
- PEANUT ALLERGIES: We are not a peanut free camp, please notify us on your enrollment form and health form if your child has a peanut allergy.
