



# Got Raw Milk?



**Rehoboth Farm** of Mendota, Virginia has dairy herdshares available for new owners, with weekly delivery points in southwest Virginia:

***What is a Herdshare?*** It provides ownership of a portion of the production of a dairy herd. Milk herdshares work from a simple premise: *A person is entitled to consume raw milk produced by a cow that they own.* Milk never enters the stream of commerce if the owner of a cow consumes their own cow's milk. Since Virginia law *forbids the sale of non-pasteurized milk*, we sell undivided shares of our herd to people who want access to raw cow's milk. In this arrangement, we and our herdshare owners can honestly assert that no milk was sold or transferred.

***Most people don't have the time or space*** for a cow. Rehoboth Farm offers a solution through boarding arrangements with each owner. The owners pay us to feed, care for and milk the cows, and in turn they receive an appropriate percentage of the herd's weekly milk production (approximately one gallon per share per week).
