Optional Extensions to Season:

Thanksgiving week Share- One Distribution the Tuesday/Wednesday before Thanksgiving

December Shares- 2 Distributions in the month of December

Produce Shares:

We offer two different sizes of produce shares: Full (intended for a small family) or Medium (intended for 2 individuals). Each week's produce share will include a wide range of produce available from our farm during that time of the season. We raise over 50 types of vegetables (200 varieties) and like to make sure that each season our members receive a nice mix of their season favorites, and maybe are introduced to some new flavors. Egg Shares:

Our Egg Share consists of fresh eggs from our Pasture Raised hens. These hens are on pasture year round (with access to shelter as desired). Their diet consists of non-GMO feed, clover, grass, grubs and insects, and select discarded produce throughout the season. Choose to receive 1 doz every other week, or 1 or more dozen weekly.

Thanksgiving week Produce/Egg Share (Optional): In order to accommodate the fact that holidays are often a time for travel, we end our main season a week before Thanksgiving, but accommodate those of you preparing your own Thanksgiving feast by offering an additional Thanksgiving week produce and egg share option. There is only one size of produce share- which is equivalent to a full share. This box will be heavy on the root crops which can be used over a period of several weeks. You can opt to add this week's produce share and any eggs you wish when signing up for the main season.

December Share- You may also choose to be part of two distributions in December- the week of December 4th and 18th. Much like the Thanksgiving week Share, we have only one size produce share available.

Other Items available to our CSA members over the season:

- **Bulk/extra items for canning/freezing**
Throughout the season, we have additional items that can be ordered/purchased at distributions. These items often include organic olive oil, honey, fruit, berries, canning quantities of items, and other goods from folks on the farm, or other local farms/businesses. We will inform you through our weekly emails about any special "extra" items that are available that week.

- **Grassfed Beef, Lamb, and free-range Pork**
We partner with Blue Rooster Farm to make grass-fed beef, lamb and free-range pork available to our members. Orders for these products can be placed directly with Blue Rooster farm, to be delivered with your shares from our farm. - **Pasture Raised Chicken:**
We will have pasture raised chicken available for our customers again this year. We plan to partner with the Reiff family (Mifflinburg, PA) to make sure our customers have the ability to purchase pasture raised chicken throughout the season
- **Thanksgiving Turkeys**
Each year we raise pastured turkeys and offer them for sale around the Thanksgiving holiday. We start accepting preorders for these turkeys in early September. On occasion we have frozen turkey available after the Thanksgiving holiday as supplies allow.

Unless other payment arrangements have been made through an agreement with the farm, the following prices assume a \$100 deposit to hold your share and payment in full no later than the first season distribution the week of May 10th, 2015 for the summer/fall season. A discount is available for payment in full made online.

**Please note: if you choose to pick your share up on-farm, you will automatically receive a discount equivalent to one week's share cost.*

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

We appreciate payments in full in advance of the season, but a \$100 deposit will hold your spot (payment in full must be made by the first distribution unless you make alternative arrangements). Payments may be made online both through ACH Bank Transfer and via credit card (paypal), or can be made by check via mail or by check/cash in person at CSA distribution. Please make checks payable to "Village Acres Farm & FoodShed." Finally, if the name on the check does not match the member name, please write the member name and number in the memo line. Please note that your deposit is the only way to hold your spot.

If alternative payment options are needed, we can arrange these on a case-by-case basis. Also, if the cost is prohibitive to signing up, inquire with us about the Community Fund by emailing us.
