## What is a CSA?

CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture. It is a program for purchasing fresh produce from a regional farm.

**CSAs are good for farmers** because they can reduce wasted food (in good years) and financial loss (in bad years), allowing for smaller farms to avoid risk.

**CSAs are good for you** because you get fresh, organic, vegetables from a farmer you know, and you become part of a community of people with shared values.
