Wood and Yard Waste

20-yard	2 tons	\$350 + zone charge
30-yard	2 tons	\$375 + zone charge

For wood or yard waste only. No dirt or rock.

Natural wood only – no painted, pressure treated, or creosote.

Concrete or Dirt

15-yard	2 tons	\$375 + zone charge
---------	--------	---------------------

Concrete and dirt may not be mixed. Weight in excess of 2 tons is billed at \$85 per ton.

15-yard dumpster is the maximum for concrete or dirt.

Trash

30-yard	2 tons	\$375 + zone charge
---------	--------	---------------------

No paint, tires, oil, explosive debris, hazardous materials, etc.

Weight in excess of 2 tons is billed at \$85 per ton.

Term and Conditions

DELIVERY:

1. There must be a property damage liability waiver signed by property owner before we will place dumpster across property lines.
2. Northwest Recycling and its agents are not responsible for any damages from truck or dumpster.
3. Customer assumes all liability for placing a can including permits and right of way.
4. Northwest Recycling is in no regard responsible for property damage.
5. Container may NOT BE MOVED once placed. If it is moved you will be responsible for property damages, damages to container, moving, and clean up fees.
6. You are responsible for following and complying with local ordinances.
7. You will also be liable for paying any citations, fines, towing, and/or impound fees.

LOADING:

While the container is in your possession you accept full responsibility for the container and the contents that are loaded inside of it. You must adhere to the following rules associated with loading the container. We accept no liability for the contents loaded into the container.

1. The container must NOT be overloaded. If the material is loaded above the top of the container we reserve the right to leave it on site for you to dispose of, with an additional fee.
2. Materials that are not accepted are: Asbestos, Paints, Gas, Oil, Cleaners, Solvents (any liquid), Tires, Haz-Mat Materials, Batteries, Chemicals, Propane, Creosote Lumber, Explosives, Freon Containing Devices.
3. You are responsible for all items placed into the dumpster, either by you or another party. We reserve the right to reject items, or charge additional fees to dispose of them.
4. Any unacceptable material will be billed to the customer.
5. Customer assumes all liability for placing the container including permits and right of way.
6. If the container is too heavy for lifting, the customer will be responsible for removing materials for it to be picked up. Additional overweight and travel fees will be applied.
7. Under the law by the Maryland Department of Transportation we are required to be a specific weight based on the vehicle and the container it is carrying. Overweight fees and citations will be the responsibility of the customer.
8. Per D.O.T. requirements, DIRT must be placed evenly within a dirt only container and may not exceed 3 quarters of the container. There can only be DIRT in the dirt only containers, no other material may be mixed in. 20-yard containers can only be used for dirt. We will not haul any containers that are overweight or overloaded. Any trash mixed in with the dirt will be subject to additional fees, in addition to overweight fees if the container is overloaded.
9. If you are using a container for CONCRETE only, it must only be concrete. Please see above rules for dirt containers. Same rules apply. No material other than concrete is permitted in the concrete containers. No re-bar or wire mesh.
10. METAL containers may only be filled with metal, please see above rules, no hazardous materials, or car parts allowed. Gas and Oil tanks are not allowed.
11. No treated woods, painted, varnished, creosote or pressure treated wood accepted into the BRUSH only containers. You may not mix trash, metal, concrete, or dirt within these loads.

PICK UP:

1. Any additional weight over maximum will be charged \$85.00 per additional ton.
2. If driver and truck cannot dump or pick up material or dumpster, customer will be charged \$125.00 per 30 minutes. Driver will wait for 5 minutes at no charge.
3. If Northwest Recycling vehicle is stuck due to direction of the customer, the customer will pay tow bill plus \$125.00 per 30 minutes of the driver's time.
4. If there is any contamination in brush/wood waste it will be considered a trash dumpster and priced accordingly.
5. Please DO NOT BLOCK FRONT OF DUMPSTER.
6. We will notify you if the container is overweight. If it is overweight, you are responsible for all the overweight fees. If you fail to pay overweight fees, we reserve the right to off load debris and trash of the same weight back onto the property.
7. If no access is available customer will be charged for a dry run. Minimum charge \$150.

PAYMENT:

1. There is a 3% handling fee on all credit card transactions.
2. We require payment up front.
3. Pricing, drop off, pick up, and dump fees are all subject to change.
4. There will be a \$35 late fee per month added to all additional charges that are not paid within the 15-day net period allowed for payment.
5. The customer agrees to pay all legal and collection fees associated with the outstanding balance.
6. A \$35 handling fee, in addition to bank fees, will be charged to customer for any returned checks.
7. We reserve the right to charge credit cards for overweight fees, loads that were unable to be picked up, and any other additional fees.
