NOTING ACC BASEBALL

• The second weekend of ACC series includes six division matchups -- Virginia at Pitt, North Carolina at Duke, Miami at Virginia Tech, Clemson at Wake Forest, and Notre Dame at Louisville ... Georgia Tech visits Florida State in the lone interdivision series ... ACC Network will carry the UNC-Duke series in its entirety, the first of six conference series set for full coverage this season.

• Florida State highlighted ACC midweek action by handing top-ranked Florida its first loss of the season, 2-1, Tuesday night in Gainesville ... Senior Antonio Velez (1-0) allowed just one hit with career-highs in innings pitched (6.0) and strikeouts (7) ... Relief pitcher Parker Messick threw the final three innings, also notching seven strikeouts, for his first career save ... The Gators were the last remaining unbeaten team in the country ... Georgia Tech also picked up a big road win over a ranked opponent, winning 6-2 at No. 14 Auburn as Baron Radcliff homered and drove in two runs.

• The FSU-Florida pitchers' duel proved a definite exception on a day ACC teams scored 121 runs in 11 games (an average of 11 runs per game) ... Virginia's offense exploded in a 24-5 rout of UMass Lowell while Virginia Tech pounded William & Mary by a 19-4 score ... Virginia tallied the program's fifth highest run total since 2000 and most in more than a decade ... The last time Virginia Tech scored at least 19 runs had been April 4, 2018 versus Dayton in a 19-2 win.

• A total of eight ACC teams are currently ranked in at least one major poll, and none of the rankings feature fewer than five ACC teams ... Top 10 rankings include Louisville (as high as No. 2), Miami (as high as No. 5), Duke (as high as No. 8) and NC State (as high as No. 9).

• Notre Dame, winner of seven straight under first-year head coach Link Jarrett, enter the Collegiate Baseball Newspaper rankings this week at No. 24. Eleven of the ACC's 14 teams have been ranked among the nation's top 25 in at least one major poll at some point this season.

• Collegiate Baseball's list of National Players of the Week for March 8 included a pair of ACC pitchers in Louisville's Reid Detmers and Virginia Tech's Ian Seymour ... Detmers struck out 15 batters over 6 innings against Wake Forest during a 4-1 win last Friday night ... Seymour struck out 14 Georgia Tech. batters in only 6 innings of work on Sunday. The 14 strikeouts are the most for a Hokie pitcher in an ACC regular-season game in school history (since 2005).

North Carolina sophomore first baseman **Aaron Sabato** has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week, while Duke junior right-hander **Bryce Jarvis** is the ACC Pitcher of the Week.

ACC baseball weekly honors are determined by a vote of a select media panel and announced on Mondays throughout the regular season.

Sabato turned in a stellar week at the plate, as he hit four home runs to take the team lead with five on the year and tie for fifth in the conference. He tallied seven RBI and registered a 1.133 slugging percentage.

Hailing from Rye Brook, New York, **Sabato** drew an astounding 11 walks last week to take over the conference lead with 19 on the year and tally a .615 on-base percentage. He put together his best performance of the week on Friday, as he was 3-for-4 at the plate with a pair of home runs and three RBIs in North Carolina's ACC opener against Notre Dame.

Jarvis worked 7.0 shutout innings to help 12th-ranked Duke to a 2-1 victory over No. 11 Florida State in Friday's series opener. Jarvis (3-1) was dominant once again for the Blue Devils, notching his third consecutive quality start. The junior right-hander allowed just one hit and one walk across his seven innings of work, while striking out 12 batters to pick up his third win of the season.

The Franklin, Tennessee, native carried a perfect game through 6.2 frames before allowing his first baserunner of the day, who reached on a strikeout wild pitch. The baserunner ended a span of 16.2 perfect innings at home for Jarvis. The right-hander has only allowed one run, seven hits and one walk across his three starts this season, totaling 23.0 innings of work with a 0.39 ERA.
