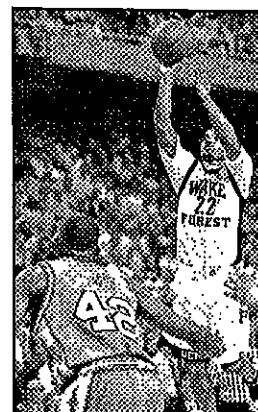

Tar Heels in Final Four



North Carolina's quest for a second national title in three years fell short when the Tar Heels dropped a 75-68 semifinal decision to the Arkansas Razorbacks in the 57th NCAA Final Four before 38,540 at the Kingdome in Seattle, Wash., making its second Final Four appearance in three years. In the 12th overall, UNC advanced to the Final Four with a 74-61 win over the top-seeded Kentucky Wildcats in the Southeast Region final.

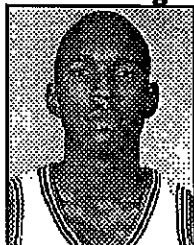

For the first time in ACC hoops history, four teams tied for first place during the regular season as Wake Forest, Virginia, Maryland and North Carolina each finished with a 12-4 mark in league play.

• Seven of the league's nine teams were ranked at least one week in the AP poll with four - Wake Forest (3), North Carolina (4), Maryland (10) and Virginia (13) each securing a Top 15 listing in the final poll.

• The ACC set a new single season attendance mark, drawing 1,547,803 fans over 141 dates...returning to the Greensboro (NC) Coliseum for the first time since 1988, the Tournament set a new attendance record drawing 114,044 over five sessions.

• The ACC had two players - Maryland's Joe Smith and North Carolina's Jerry Stackhouse - earn National Player of the Year honors... Smith and Stackhouse were unanimous All-America selections.

Wake Forest claims ACC title



Wake Forest's Demon Deacons captured their first ACC title since 1962, and third overall, defeating North Carolina 82-80 in overtime in the 42nd annual ACC Tournament held at the Greensboro (N.C.) Coliseum...Wake Forest guard Randolph Childress was voted Tournament MVP after scoring a touney record 107 points in three games, including the game-winning basket against the Tar Heels with four seconds left to play in the title game.

Smith leads All-ACC team

Maryland sophomore Joe Smith heads up the 1995 All-ACC team as picked by AP and the Atlantic Coast Sports Writers Association (ACSWA)...only the fourth Terp to lead the ACC in scoring (20.8) ...second in rebounds (10.6), blocked shots (2.9), third in field goal percentage (.578), eighth in steals (1.6) and 10th in free throw percentage (.741)...an all-time high four sophomores were named first team All-ACC; the previous high was two on eight occasions...Wake Forest's Randolph Childress was the lone senior named to the elite squad...In all, seven sophomores were named to the first three teams...the 1995 All-ACC teams are as follows:

Talented Terps

Maryland become only the third team in ACC history to have five double-figure scorers two seasons in a row...Duke did so in their back-to-back championship seasons of 1991 and 1992 while the Terrapins had five double-figure scorers for five straight seasons from 1974 through 1979.

Smith ACC Player of the Year

Maryland All-America Joe Smith was landslide winner in voting for the 1995 AP/ACSWA Player of the Year in the ACC...Smith received 84 of 106 votes cast...only the fourth Maryland player to capture the conference's top honor and the first since Len Bias won the award in 1986.

ACC Rookie of the Year, Gregg Buckner of Clemson, heads up the 1995 All-ACC Freshman team...only the fourth freshman in league history to lead his team in scoring (12.0), rebounding (5.9) and field goal percentage (.526), out-distanced Georgia Tech's Matt Harpring to become the first Clemson player to earn ACC Rookie of the Year honors.

Tim Duncan

Wake Forest's Tim Duncan has blocked at least one shot in each of his 65 career games...with 124 "rejections" last year and 135 blocks this year, the St. Croix, VI, native, joins Virginia's Ralph Sampson as only the second player in ACC history to record 100 blocks in each of his first two seasons...led the ACC in rebounding with a 12.5 per game average, the best mark since Maryland's Len Elmore averaged 14.7 rebounds in 1974...led the ACC with 2.1 "doubles-doubles" this year and has 35 for his career.

Odom cops coaching award

Wake Forest's Dave Odom, whose Deacons advanced to the "Sweet 16" of the NCAA Tournament, was tabbed as the AP/ACSWA Coach of the Year in the ACC...In winning the award for the second straight year and third time in five years, Odom guided the Deacons (a pre-season pick for fifth place in the ACC) to a 26-6 overall record and the school's first ACC title since 1962.

Bob Sura

Florida State senior Bob Sura became the first player in ACC history to record 2,000 points, 700 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals...ACC freshman of the Year in 1992, Sura earned first team All-ACC honors in 1994 and second team listings in 1993 and 1995...first on FSU's all-time scoring list (2,130) and 19th among ACC career scoring leaders...2nd on the school steal list (209), 4th in assists (435), 11th in rebounding (714)...became the 13th player in league history to record a "triple-double" when he had 19 points, 12 rebounds and 12 assists in a 107-79 victory over N.C. State on Jan. 15.

Three among Wooden finalists

Jerry Stackhouse and Rasheed Wallace from North Carolina and Wake Forest's Randolph Childress were among 15 finalists for the annual John R. Wooden Award...UCLA's Ed O'Bannon later won the award.

ACC Online

The ACC Tournament became one of the first college sporting events to be offered on the Internet when the Greensboro News & Record featured the Tournament on their Triad Online from March 1-31...features that were available included an updated scoreboard, a trivia contest, background information about the ACC, game stories, photos, play-by-play, coaches' comments and stats for each game.

Coaches' condition

Two ACC coaches, Maryland's Gary Williams and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, missed portions of the 1994-95 season while a third - Virginia's Jeff Jones - "coached" injured...Krzyzewski, who had back surgery for a ruptured disc in October, stepped aside on Jan. 6 because of back problems and did not coach again for the remainder of the season...Williams contracted pneumonia and was sidelined for a total of four games, including the Terps' two ACC Tournament games, before returning for the NCAA Tournament...Jones broke his left hand in an altercation with a blackboard following a 71-62 loss at Maryland on Feb. 1...coached the remainder of the season with a cast...the Cavaliers were 12-6 "pre-blackboard" and 13-3 "post-blackboard".

Terps to face UCLA

Maryland is slated to play defending NCAA Champion UCLA on Dec. 9 in the second annual John R. Wooden Classic at the Pond in Anaheim, Calif...the two teams last played one another on Dec. 23, 1982, with the Terps posting a 80-79 win in overtime.

Sagarin Computer

With four teams listed in its Top 10, the Sagarin computer rated the ACC as the nation's toughest conference in 1995...the Big Eight was second (84.81), followed by the Pac-10 (82.92) and SEC (82.15)...the Sagarin computer rankings are (with NCAA Tournament teams and records) are as follows:

Three ACC high school basketball recruits were among 22 players in the 18th annual McDonald's All-America game April 2 at the Kiel Center in St. Louis...selected to play were Duke's Taymon Domzalski, Georgia Tech's Stephon Marbury and North Carolina's Antawn Jamison.

Deacons retire jerseys

Wake Forest announced at the end of the season that the school would retire the jersey numbers of Rodney Rogers (#54) and Randolph Childress (#22)...Rogers is currently playing for the NBA's Denver Nuggets...Rogers and Childress will join five other Deacons who have already had their numbers retired.

Smith, Stackhouse National Players of Year

Maryland sophomore Joe Smith was tabbed as the national Player of the Year by the Associated Press, Nismith and United Press International...North Carolina sophomore Jerry Stackhouse was *Sports Illustrated's* pick as national Player of the Year...Smith, only the sixth sophomore to be selected as AP Player of the Year in the 35 years of the award, averaged 20.7 points and 13 rebounds in three NCAA Tournament games...Smith and Stackhouse were both unanimous first-team All-America selections.

Tech left out of NCAA field

Georgia Tech, which had played in nine straight NCAA Tournaments before last season, missed out on an NCAA berth for the second straight year in 1995...since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985, the Jackets are only the second ACC team with a .500 or better league record (and was eligible) not to make the NCAA field; Virginia captured the 1992 NIT crown after finishing the regular season 8-8 in the ACC and 15-13 overall...ranked in the AP poll for 15 weeks during the season, Tech finished the season 18-12 and ranked 53rd in the RPI Report...non-conference schedule was ranked as the 47th toughest by RPI and included 14 games against teams seeded No. 4-or-higher in the NCAA Tournament.

Childress scores Tourney mark

Wake Forest guard Randolph Childress' game-winning shot against North Carolina with four seconds left to play in the title game of the ACC Tournament gave the Deacons their first league title since 1962...named ACC Tournament MVP after scoring a tournament record 107 points, eclipsing the previous mark of 106 points set by UNC's Len Rosenbluth in 1957.

Travis Best

Georgia Tech guard Travis Best finished his collegiate career listed among ACC career leaders in nine statistical categories, including fourth in three-point field goals and ninth in assists...fell eight assists short of joining former North Carolina standout Phil Ford (1975-78) as only the second player in ACC history to score at least 2,000 points and hand out 700 assists.

2,000 and one (short)

The ACC fell 22 points short of having four players in the same season reach the 2,000-point plateau for only the third time in league history...Wake Forest's Randolph Childress led the way with 2,208 points, followed by Florida State's Bob Sura (2,130) and Georgia Tech's Travis Best (2,057)...Georgia Tech's James Forrest and Virginia's Junior Burroughs finished with 1,978 and 1,970 points, respectively...the only two times the league had four players reach the 2,000 point mark in the season were in 1981 and 1986.

Randolph Childress

Wake Forest All-America guard Randolph Childress finished second on the Deacons' all-time scoring list with 2,208 points and fifth in assists (472) and steals (180)...only senior named first team All-ACC this past season...only the eighth player in ACC history to score 2,000 points and hand out 400 assists...a finalist for the both the Wooden and Naismith Awards...scored in double figures in 109 of 120 career games...MVP of the 1995 ACC Tournament after scoring a tournament-record 107 points in leading the Deacons to their first ACC title since 1962.

Heels No. 1

North Carolina is the all-time winningest team in Division I-A with 1,626 wins...Kentucky is second at 1,616, followed by Kansas (1,567), St. John's (1,508) and Duke (1,474)...the Tar Heels have posted 40 seasons with 20 or more victories and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 89 straight weeks, second only to Arizona's streak of 141 consecutive Top 25 rankings.
