## AVCA FALL WEEK 7 COACHES POLL

Five ACC teams are ranked in the Nov. 11 AVCA Fall Top 15 Coaches Poll, the most of any conference. Notre Dame leads the league at No. 5, followed by No. 6 Louisville, No. 7 Georgia Tech, No. 9 Pitt and No. 12 Miami. Duke and Syracuse are receiving votes.

Louisville leads the nation in blocks per set with 3.43, and rank 10th in hitting percentage (.263). Notre Dame (sixth, 2.67), Pitt (seventh, 2.58) and Duke (eighth, 2.56) are in the top 10 nationally in blocks per set. Pitt (fourth, 13.71), Notre Dame (seventh, 13.46) and Georgia Tech (10th, 12.90) are among the top 10 in the NCAA in assists per set. Georgia Tech (fourth, .326) and Miami (ninth, .269) join Louisville in the top 10 in hitting percentage, and Notre Dame is fifth nationally in digs per set (17.73). NC State is 10th in the nation in opponent hitting percentage (.157).

Louisville (Oct. 3 at Boston College) and Pitt (Oct. 18 at Notre Dame) both recorded 19.0 team blocks in a match, the most by any team in a four-set match. Georgia Tech racked up 55 kills in an Oct. 7 win against Florida State, the most kills in a three-set match by any Division I team this season.

Louisville's Amaya Tillman leads the nation with 2.00 blocks per set. Her teammate Aiko Jones (eighth, 1.43) and Pitt's Sabrina Starks (ninth, 1.29) rank in the top 10 in blocks per set. Florida State's Emma Clothier is third nationally with a .507 hitting percentage. Miami's Janice Leao (seventh, .473) and Notre Dame's Lindsey Miller (ninth, .444) are also among the top 10 nationally in hitting percentage. Notre Dame's Zoe Nunez (fourth, 11.58), Miami's Savannah Vach (sixth, 11.45) and Georgia Tech's Matti McKissock (10th, 10.76) sit among the NCAA leaders in assists per set. Syracuse's Lauren Hogan (sixth, 5.15), Notre Dame's Hattie Monson (seventh, 4.92) and Virginia's Alexandra Spencer (eighth, 4.88) rank among the top 10 in the nation in digs per set.

## NOTES OF INTEREST

Duke's Mackenzie Cole tallied six aces against Virginia on Oct. 30, the most of any Division I player this season in a three-set match. Georgia Tech's Mariana Brambilla's 23 kills against Clemson on Oct. 22 are the most kills by any Division I player in a three-set match this season. Pitt's Chinaza Ndee recorded a .739 hitting percentage on Oct. 10 against Boston College, the best single-match hitting percentage by any Division I player this season with at least 20 attempts.

Four of the top 20 winningest active head coach reside in the ACC, including two of the top four: Florida State's Chris Poole (third, 844 wins), North Carolina's Joe Sagula (fourth, 823), Duke's Jolene Nagel (14th, 648) and Syracuse's Leonid Yelin (17th, 604).

ACC Unity Week was developed through the efforts of the ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) in conjunction with its member institutions. **ACC COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE**


The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.

- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

"I applaud the work of ACC CORE and the initiatives collaborated on and adopted by our schools," said ACC Commissioner John Swofford. "It is critically important for our country to unite as one. The ACC is committed to creating meaningful change, eradicating racism, and upholding the values of equality, diversity and non-discrimination."

"In a time of great challenges where society seems more divided than ever before, we the student-athletes of the ACC want to take a stand against racism, discrimination and any other form of injustice," said Leon Krapp from the NC State Men's Soccer Team and the ACC's representative to NCAA SAAC. "As athletes, we know that sport has the power to unite people from all backgrounds. However, we are more than just athletes. Therefore, we want to use our platforms to advocate for a more tolerant, understanding and inclusive environment on our campuses and beyond. We will overcome our current challenges if we act together and united. #UNITE!"

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: ***"We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."***

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
- Fairness
