ACC QUICK HITS

- Four ACC teams are ranked in the national polls: Duke (No. 4 AP/USA Today), Louisville (No. 5 AP/6 USA Today), North Carolina (No. 17 AP/18 USA Today) and NC State (No. 23 AP/22 USA Today).

- ACC teams are outscoring foes by an average of 18.8 ppg, which is the second largest scoring margin of any conference nationally this season.

- ACC teams already have racked up 19 100-point games (out of 102 total games). That is the league's most in non-conference play since the 1992-93 season (19). ACC teams posted 11 100-point games in non-conference play last season. (*StatsPerform*)

- ACC teams are averaging 85.9 ppg this season, which is second most among all leagues. ACC programs averaged 77.7 per game in regular-season non-conference games last season.

- ACC teams have combined to limit their opponents to 67.0 ppg, which is fewest of any conference.

- SMU's B.J. Edwards earned ACC Player of the Week honors, while A pair of freshmen, Duke's Cameron Boozer and Louisville's Mikel Brown Jr., shared the ACC Player and Rookie of the Week honors for games played Nov. 10-16.

- Fifteen ACC teams started 3-0 this season. That is the most by any conference in 2025-26 and the most by the ACC in any season ever. (*StatsPerform*)

- Five ACC freshmen rank among the top 11 freshmen nationally in scoring, led by Stanford's Ebuka Okorie at 23.8 ppg:

3. Cameron Boozer, Duke, 21.1 ppg
4. Caleb Wilson, UNC, 20.6 ppg
6. Mikel Brown Jr., Louisville, 19.8 ppg
11. Thijs De Ridder, Virginia, 17.5 ppg

- ACC players have combined for four of the top six freshman scoring outputs in the country this season:

1. Cameron Boozer, Duke - 35 vs. Indiana State
2. Neoklis Avdalas, VT - 33 vs Providence
- T5. Mikel Brown Jr., Louisville - 29 vs. No. 9 Kentucky
- T5. Ebuka Okorie, Stanford - 29 vs Montana

- Following a vote of the league's media, Duke was chosen as the preseason favorite to win the 2026 ACC Championship. The Blue Devils were followed in the poll by Louisville, UNC, NC State and Virginia.

- For the first time since the 2018-19 season, ACC teams will play 18-game conference schedules. League play begins on Tuesday, Dec. 30.

- NC State's Darrion Williams was named the Preseason ACC Player of the Year, while Duke's Cameron Boozer was tabbed Preseason Rookie of the Year.

- Williams and Boozer were joined on the Preseason All-ACC First Team and by ND's Markus Burton and Louisville's Mikel Brown Jr. and Ryan Conwell.

- Four new head coaches are on ACC sidelines this season: Luke Loucks (FSU), Jai Lucas (Miami), Will Wade (NC State) and Ryan Odom (UVA).

- Three members of the 2025 All-ACC Team are back for the 2025-26 season: Notre Dame's Markus Burton (second team), GT's Baye Ndongo (third team) and SMU's Boopie Miller (third team). Burton also was a third-team honoree in 2024.

- At 21.3 ppg, Burton was the ACC's leading scorer in 2024-25. ND also added the nation's leading rebounder from 2024-25, Carson Towt from Northern Arizona. He averaged 12.4 rpg last season.

- The ACC's 2025 Most Improved Player honoree, BC's Donald Hand Jr., also returns this season.

- 28 international players are starting their college careers this season at ACC schools; 14 ACC teams welcomed a first-year international recruit this season.

- Seven ACC schools ranked among the ESPN's top recruiting class rankings: Duke (1), UNC (8), Notre Dame (9), SMU (10), Syracuse (14), Georgia Tech (17) and Miami (23).

- Clemson's Brad Brownell (28th, 465) and Virginia Tech's Mike Young (40th, 409) rank among the active national leaders in wins as a head coach.

- Duke won its second ACC title in three seasons and its 23rd ACC championship overall in 2025. Duke has won four of the last eight ACC Tournaments that have been completed, including 2017, 2019, 2023 and 2025.

- ACC Men's Basketball has won 15 NCAA national championships, including three of the last 10. Teams currently in the ACC have combined to win eight of the last 24 NCAA crowns and 19 overall.

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Current league members have won more than 28,000 games and have had 933 NBA Draft picks, including 318 first-round selections.
- All 18 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including 10 schools with more than 1,500.
- The ACC features four of the eight winningest programs in NCAA history: North Carolina (3rd), Duke (4th), Syracuse (6th) and Notre Dame (8th).
- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 56 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 20% of the nation's consensus All-Americans.

NCAA Tournament Success

- ACC Men's Basketball has won 15 NCAA national championships, including three since 2015.
- Teams currently in the ACC have combined to win eight of the last 24 NCAA crowns and 19 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles, followed by Duke (5), Louisville (2), NC State (2) and Cal, Stanford, Syracuse and Virginia (1 apiece).
- With 492 wins and a .655 winning percentage, the ACC is the all-time winningest conference in the NCAA Tournament. The ACC's current 18 members have combined for 734 NCAA Tournament victories.
- Since 1985, nearly half of the ACC teams that earned NCAA Tournament bids have reached the Sweet 16 (106 of 218).

Recent Tournament Success

- Since 2015, the ACC leads all conferences in Final Four appearances (10) and NCAA Tournament wins (116).
- The ACC is 116-61 (.655) in NCAA Tournament play over the last 10 tournaments (2015-19, '21-25). The total of 116 wins is the most of any conference.
- Since 2016, six different ACC schools have reached the Final Four (Duke, Miami, North Carolina, NC State, Syracuse, Virginia).
- The ACC has had eight different schools (16 total) make the Sweet 16 in the last six tournaments.
- Duke advanced to the 2025 NCAA Men's Final Four, becoming the fifth ACC school to reach the national semis in the last four years (most of any league).

Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final Associated Press poll in 62 of the last 64 seasons.
- ACC teams have been ranked No. 1 in the AP poll 300 times – by far the most of any conference.

ACC and the NBA

- 76 alumni from current ACC programs were on Opening Night NBA rosters for the 2025-26 season. Sixteen of the 18 ACC programs had at least one former player on an NBA Opening Day roster, while nine schools boasted at least three alumni on NBA rosters.
- On 2025 Opening Night rosters, 27 of the 30 NBA teams had at least one player from an ACC program.
- Duke led all ACC schools with 24 alumni on NBA rosters – second most of any program nationally. North Carolina was represented by nine alumni on Opening Day rosters, while Virginia had seven.
- 84 alumni from current ACC schools appeared in at least one NBA game during the 2024-25 season. Seventeen active ACC programs had at least one alum play in the NBA last season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had multiple first-round picks in each of the past 17 NBA Drafts (since 2009). In that span, the ACC leads all conferences in first-round (92) and overall selections (150).
- Eight ACC student-athletes were selected in the 2025 NBA Draft, including four first-round picks (three in lottery).

ACC AVAILABILITY REPORTING

• On July 22, 2025, the ACC announced two new policies to enhance the safety and well-being of ACC student-athletes in the 2025-26 academic year.

(1) Institutional event security plans will limit access to the competition area in football and men's and women's basketball.

(2) the availability status of student-athletes will be reported before each conference game in football, baseball, men's and women's basketball.

• Before each conference game, a team will disclose any student-athlete whose availability for the upcoming game is in question. A student-athlete can be listed on the Availability Report if their status is uncertain for any reason (e.g., injury or illness, academic or other eligibility issue, personal or family matter, etc.); however, only the status and not the specific reason will be publicly reported.

• In men's/women's basketball, a report will be submitted the night before the game, prior to each Conference game (e.g., Friday before a Saturday game), with an additional update on game day.

• For each report submitted before game day, student-athletes will be designated as Available, Probable, Questionable or Out for the upcoming game. Game Day Reports will be submitted two hours before each game. For this report, student-athletes will be designated as Available, Game Time Decision, or Out.

• All availability reports and the full conference policy will be available to the public and media on the ACC's website – www.theACC.com.

• Availability reporting starts December 29 prior to the first Conference games.

* This policy is intended to help protect student-athletes and staff members from outside entities seeking to obtain inside information about availability and participation, including but not limited to injuries. It will also reinforce to athletes and staff the sensitivity of such information.

ACCN tele-vises more than 500 regular-season and tournament games from across the conference's 28 sponsored sports plus a complement of news and information shows and original programming. Together, ACCN and its digital platform, ACCNX, combine to feature more than 1,500 ACC events each year.
