Annual Awards

Kevin Roberson Player of the Year Award

The Kevin A. Roberson Player of the Year Award is given annually to the America East Player of the Year in men's basketball. The award is determined by a vote of the league's coaches.

Roberson played basketball four years at the University of Vermont, and graduated with a degree in electrical engineering in 1992. He was a first-team All-North Atlantic Conference selection for two years and was named the conference's Player of the Year in 1991-92.

A tremendous scorer, rebounder and a tenacious defender, he finished his career fourth on the NCAA's career blocked shots list with 402, trailing only Alonzo Mourning, Rodney Blake and Shaquille O'Neal. He also ranks fourth on the America East career rebound list with 1,054.

Roberson holds the conference record for most blocks in a game (13), season (139) and career. Following graduation from Vermont in 1992, he served as a volunteer assistant coach with the Catamounts. Roberson died in a tragic automobile accident in his hometown of Buffalo, N.Y., May 8, 1993.

America East named the conference player of the year in memory of Roberson for the 1993-94 season.

Roberson is widely recognized as one of the finest players and gentlemen to compete in America East.

Reggie Lewis Most Outstanding Player Award

The Reggie Lewis Award is given each year to the most outstanding player in the America East Men's Basketball Championship. The award, based upon play in the entire postseason tournament, is determined by a vote of media at the championship game.

The award was named in memory of Lewis prior to the 1993-94 season. A four-year standout on the Northeastern basketball team, Lewis is the only three-time winner of the America East (then North Atlantic Conference) Player of the Year Award and was named the championship's most outstanding player twice. In addition, he received the conference's Rookie of the Year honors for the 1983-84 season.

While at Northeastern, Lewis led the Huskies to four-straight America East titles, and is still the conference's career scoring leader with 2,709 points.

Lewis was drafted in the first round of the 1987 NBA Draft by the Boston Celtics, and went on to a distinguished career with the Celtics. He was selected as team captain for the 1993-94 season.

Lewis died July 27, 1993 of a heart ailment, while shooting baskets at Brandeis University. He received a posthumous bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Northeastern, as well as an honorary Doctorate of Humanities in May, 1994.

Denis E. Lambert Championship Trophy

The Denis E. Lambert Championship Trophy is awarded annually to the America East men's basketball championship team. The award is named for the longtime athletic administrator at the University of Vermont.

"Deny" Lambert retired in August, 1992, after serving as Director of Athletics at Vermont for 19 years. He held various positions on the UVM staff for 32 years. During his tenure, Vermont expanded its program to include teams in 26 intercollegiate sports. Several of those teams had regional and national success, including four NCAA national championship teams.

In 1985, Lambert received Vermont's most prestigious honor, the Distinguished Service Award. He is known as a man who played the game fairly and honorably, and was elected by his peers to positions in many regional and NCAA organizations, including the presidency of the North Atlantic Conference, Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC), Vermont Headmasters' Association, NCAA Ski Committee and the Vermont Special Olympics.

UVM won its first America East Championship in 2003 as head coach Tom Brennan, originally hired by Lambert in 1986, made his first appearance in the NCAA Championship as a player or coach. The Catamounts followed that with two more wins in 2004 and 2005.
