ON TAP: The fifth-seeded Boston University women's basketball team (15-14, 7-9 AE) will take on No. 4 Binghamton University on Friday, March 9, at 8 p.m., in the quarterfinals of the America East Women's Basketball Tournament, held at Binghamton's Events Center in Vestal, N.Y.

THE TERRIERS: BU ended the regular season winning three of its last five contests, including a 72-70 nailbiter to Binghamton in the regular-season finale. The Terriers are the fifth seed, following a closely contested end to the regular season between BU, Binghamton, Maine, UMBC and Vermont.

As she has all season, senior tri-captain Katie Meinhardt enters the America East Tournament as the team's leader in points per game with 12.7. Senior tri-captain Erica Kovach and freshman Aly Hinton each average 6.2 rebounds per game - tops on the team.

The Terriers have used a steady rotation of players as 10 on the active roster have seen action in at least 22 of 29 games this season. A balanced attack has allowed a number of different individuals to lead BU in scoring, as Kovach, Hinton and junior Cheri Raffo have averaged nine points per game or better all season. In addition, Meinhardt, Raffo and sophomore Kristi Dini provided viable threats from behind the arc. Between the three, they average 71.9 percent of BU's 3-pointers.

SCOUTING THE BEARCATS: Binghamton closed out the regular season with a 66-61 victory over New Hampshire on Saturday, March 3. Senior Shea Kenny notched a career-high 18 points and four players scored in double digits. The Bearcats are 11-18 overall and have dropped three of the last four games. They are third in the conference in field goal defense, holding opponents to a .393 shooting percentage. The Bearcats can also hit the outside shot, ranking second in AE with a .358 percentage from behind the arc. Nationally, they are 48th in 3-point field

goal percentage. Binghamton averages 3.52 blocks per game, more than anyone in the conference.

BU VS. BINGHAMTON: Tonight's game marks the first time that Boston Univ. and Binghamton will meet in the AE Tourney.

The series with Binghamton is relatively young, compared with other opponents in the America East, since the Bearcats joined the conference in 2001-02. The Terriers lead the all-time series, 7-5, and Boston University has taken four of the last six meetings. At Case Gym, the Terriers are 5-1 while they own a 2-4 road record with the Bearcats. There has been one overtime game in the series - a 67-62 Boston University win on Jan. 8, 2005. Last year, the Terriers swept the season series with 77-68 and 77-65 victories, respectively.

LAST TIME VS. BINGHAMTON (FEB. 28, 2007): Fighting for playoff positioning, BU used an 18-0 run over six minutes in the second half to eclipse a 10-point deficit and hold off Binghamton, 72-70, on Wednesday, Feb. 28 at Case Gym. Senior Erica Kovach provided the heroics in her final regular-season game, converting the game-winning lay up with only seven seconds left from classmate Katie Meinhardt. Kovach finished with 10 points while fellow senior Katie Meinhardt added 16 points on 7-of-16 from the field. Sophomore Amarachi Umez-Eronini scored 16 of her career- and game-high 22 points in the second half as the Terriers scored the next 18 points in five and a half minutes to take their first lead since midway through the first half.

NEXT TIME OUT: With a win, the Terriers would face either No. 8 Albany, No. 9 UNH or No. 1 Hartford in the AE semifinals. On the other side of the bracket is No. 2 Stony Brook, No. 3 Vermont, No. 6 Maine and No. 7 UMBC.

TERRIERS IN THE AE TOURNAMENT:

* BU aims to reach the title game for the fifth consecutive season in 2006-07.

* BU enters the tournament as the No. 5 seed for the first time since 1995. As the fifth-seeded team, the Terriers are 1-2 all-time.

* In two out of the past three seasons, BU has been slotted as the No. 3 team, and has gone 4-2 in the third spot.

* In 2005, the Terriers made a bid to become the first No. 8 seed to win the conference championship; however, they came up just short of the feat, losing a 52-50 heartbreaker to Hartford.

* Three Terriers average double figures in post-season play, as senior tri-captain Katie Meinhardt, sophomore Jesyka Burks-Wiley and junior tri-captain Cheri Raffo have averaged 15.4, 14.0 and 10.0 points per game, respectively.

* Last year, Burks-Wiley hauled in 20 rebounds and 16 points against Stony Brook in the semifinals. Her 20 boards set a new BU record for rebounds in the tournament.

HOLDING ON TO THE BALL: The Terriers had only six turnovers in its regular-season finale - a season low for the scarlet and white. BU is now 48th in the country in turnovers per game with 15.4.

KINNEARY DISHES IT OUT: Sophomore guard Christine Kinneary has handed out a team-high 90 assists in 29 games this season - good for seventh in the conference. She is also sixth in America East in assist/turnover ratio (1.34). The native of Plainedge, N.Y., has seen action in every game this season, starting 13.

SIMPLY DEVINE: Junior center Kasey Devine had a career night at Hartford on Wednesday, Feb. 21. Playing at Chase Arena and being viewed regionally on NESN, Devine put together her best outing of the season and possibly her collegiate career. On 5-of-12 shooting, and 6-of-8 from the free-throw line, the native of Kingstown, R.I., poured in 16 points, to go along with 10 rebounds and three blocks. For her efforts, Devine earned America East Player of the Game. After battling through a bout of illness earlier in the season, Devine has gradually been seeing more action recently and over the past seven games has averaged 7.7 ppg.

KOVACH DOMINATES THE GLASS: Senior tri-captain Erica Kovach has led, or shared the lead, in rebounding in 11 games this season. Along with freshman Aly Hinton, Kovach leads the Terriers with 6.2 rebounds per game. Her season high was 14, recorded against Northeastern on Nov. 21, 2006.

UMEZ-ERONINI STEPS UP: Since the start of the conference slate, sophomore guard Amarachi Umez-Eronini has seen a drastic increase in playing time and has responded by putting up career numbers. She has increased her time on the court by 7.2 minutes per game, and posted 105 points, compared to her 50 during the non-conference schedule. Recently, Umez-Eronini recorded a career-best 22 points against Binghamton on Feb. 28 in the regular-season finale.

HINTON AMONG AE'S TOP FRESHMEN: Among the top scoring freshmen in the conference, Aly Hinton currently ranks third, behind UVM's freshman duo of Courtney Pilypaitis and May Kotsopoulos, with 9.0 points per game. She is second in rebounding - Diana Delva leads with 8.3 - and third in blocks (0.65). In addition, she is fourth in field goal percentage (.477) and assists (1.48), proving she is a threat on the offensive and defensive ends.

TERRIERS NEARLY UPSET HARTFORD AT HOME: BU nearly pulled off an upset over Hartford on Feb. 21 at Chase Arena, as the Hawks edged BU by a 64-60 margin. The Hawks have not lost to a conference opponent at home since Feb. 19, 2005. The Terriers, WHO came within four points of pulling it off, became only the second team this season to come within four points at Chase Arena. Earlier this season, UNH dropped a 48-47 decision in West Hartford. The Terriers also posted the second highest point total recorded at Chase Arena by a conference opponent in 2006-07. Binghamton put up 64 early this year.

ALBANY A TRIP BU WILL

NEVER FORGET: With a fierce snowstorm raging outside, the women's basketball team took to the court at Albany looking like a differnet team. The reason for that was the Terriers were playing in their practice gear. When the storm prevented the team from getting back to the hotel to change, the Terriers were forced to compete in their practice uniforms and have a pre-game meal delivered from the Albany dining hall. Despite the fact that their pre-game schedule was thrown off, the Terriers responded to the adverse conditions and went on to defeat the Great Danes by a 64-53 margin.

BU EARNS SEASON-HIGH 11 STEALS: On Feb. 14 at Albany, the Terriers earned a season-high 11 steals in the contest, including Kasey Devine's four, matching a career high for the junior.

TERRIERS SINK 11 TREYS VS. STONY BROOK: BU and Stony Brook lit up the scoreboard on Feb. 10, scoring a combined 36 points by the seventh minute of action. Throughout the remainder of the game, BU went on to drain 11 of its 24 3-point attempts, the most since Jan. 29, 2006, versus Maine. On that day, the Terriers were 11-of-21 from the arc.

MAKE IT A DOUBLE: Freshman Aly Hinton is averaging an impressive 9.9 points per game in conference action. She

successfully posted back-to-back double-doubles for the Terriers during the week of Feb. 4. She scored 18 points and 11 rebounds on Feb. 4 versus UMBC, setting a new career mark, then upped that one game later with a 22-point performance that helped lead BU past UVM on Feb. 7. In the Vermont game, the freshman forward also hauled in 11 rebounds. They were the first two double-doubles of her career. This is the second consecutive season, a Terrier freshman has put together back-to-back double-doubles, as Jesyka Burks-Wiley accomplished the feat last year in the AE Tournament. Against SBU, Burks-Wiley posted 16 points and 20 rebounds, then followed that up with 17 points and 10 rebounds against Hartford in the championship game.

MEINHARDT PASSES FORMER TEAMMATE FOR EIGHTH SPOT:

Senior Katie Meinhardt recently eclipsed former teammate Adrienne Norris ('05) for the eighth spot on BU's all-time scoring list. Meinhardt broke into the top 10 on the all-time scoring list on Jan. 31 versus Hartford. Since then, Meinhardt has continued to post the numbers needed to move up on the list. The senior guard now has 1,179 career points.

BU WINS BATTLE OF THE

BOARDS: Against UMBC on Feb. 4, the Terriers won the battle of the boards by a 49-26 margin - matching a season high for rebounds in a game. BU grabbed

23 more boards than its opponent, the largest margin in 16 years. On March 2, 1991, BU outrebounded Northeastern, 50-21.

TERRIERS IN THE NATIONAL RANKS: BU currently stands second in the conference and 31st in the nation in free throw percentage with a team percentage of 74.5. Against UMBC on Sunday, Feb. 4, BU was 21-of-23 at the line - its highest percentage of the season when given 20 or more attempts from the charity stripe. Senior tri-captain Katie Meinhardt leads the team in free-throw accuracy, hitting 80.4 percent of her attempts and ranks 96th nationally.

The Terriers can also hit the outside shot, ranking 32nd in the nation in 3-pointers per game with a 6.1 average. They are also 48th in turnovers per game with 15.4.

RAFFO EXCELS IN CONFERENCE ACTION: From Jan. 10 to Jan. 31, junior Cheri Raffo had a six-game double-digit scoring streak

going that was the longest of her career. During those six games, Raffo averaged 13.6 points per game. Since the new year, the junior guard has turned up the offense, averaging 9.6 ppg in conference action. Raffo has made a habit of excelling during the conference season, last year at this time she was averaging 11.0 ppg.

FROM DOWNTOWN: The key to the Terriers' success this season has been their long-range shooting. They are .334 (178-533) from behind the 3-point arc, while holding opponents to a .306 average (132-432). The Terriers have averaged higher percentages in 19-of-29 games this season and have hit more treys in 20-of-29 games.

3-POINT SCORING STREAK: The Terriers have successfully hit at least one 3-point attempt in each of the past 131 games, a streak that spans over four seasons. The last time BU went a full game without hitting a 3-pointer was on Feb. 8, 2003 against Binghamton. Within those 131 games, the Terriers have hit 33.5 percent (809-2,415) of their 3-point attempts.

CLASS ACTS: While BU is considered a young team with three freshmen and five sophomores, the Terriers have been led by their tri-captains Katie Meinhardt, Erica Kovach and Cheri Raffo all season. Meinhardt is the team's leader in points per game (12.7) and has

reached double-figure scoring in all but eight games she has played in this season.

Kovach is tops in rebounding with a 6.2 average and has scored 9.6 ppg, good for second on the team, while Raffo has been a mainstay in the Terriers line-up, logging 851 minutes and averaging 9.0 ppg. Raffo has also reached double figures in 15 games, including six consecutive from Jan. 10 to Jan. 31.

In 18 of the 29 games this season, one of the tri-captains has led the team in scoring.

FIELD TRIP DAY: The BU women's basketball team hosted 1,300 schoolchildren on Wednesday, Jan. 31. Snapple School Day is a part of the Snapple Sport Support program, a community-based, joint-initiative between Snapple and Agganis Arena started in the 2005-06 season. The program provides opportunities for underprivileged youth in the Boston area to attend BU women's basketball, women's ice hockey and men's basketball games. Through the program, Agganis Arena has provided more than fifty nonprofit youth-based organizations with more than 3,000 tickets to BU athletic events.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS: The Terriers wrapped up their non-conference schedule at the Blue Sky Classic on Dec. 29 and Dec. 30. Since its season-opening win to URI, they put together an 8-5 record, with two wins over the Atlantic 10 conference (URI, Dayton), a victory

over the Big East (St. John's), two wins over the Ivy League (Harvard, Brown), cross-town rival Northeastern and Eastern Michigan. Three of the Terriers' losses came to ranked opponents (then-No. 7 UConn, then-No. 14 ASU, No. 3 Duke), one came to a team that was receiving votes (Delaware) and the fifth came in the home opener to Canisius.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK: Ten players on BU's roster have scored in double-figures at least once this season, while seven different athletes have led the team in scoring in a contest. Senior tri-captain Katie Meinhardt has reached double figures in 20-of-28 games she has played in this season. Recently, freshman Aly Hinton has stepped in as BU's top scoring threat, recording double-figures in the past four of eight games.

Against URI on Nov. 14, five players scored in double digits - Cheri Raffo (16 pts), Meinhardt (15 pts), Kristi Dini (14 pts), Christine Kinneary (11 pts) and Kristen Folk (11 pts).

In its highest offensive output of the season - a 93-79 win over Northeastern on Nov. 21 - four players scored in double digits, including Meinhardt and Raffo who put up 26 and 21 points, respectively.

SHE SHOOTS... SHE SCORES!: Since her freshman year, senior Katie Meinhardt has been an offensive force to be reckoned with. In 109 appearances, the senior has tallied double-digits in 53 games, including 20-of-28

games this season. She has scored 20 or more points in 11 games, and the Terriers have gone 9-2 in those games. One of those contests included a school-record 43 points against Stony Brook in the 2005 America East Championship first-round game.

Meinhardt is averaging 12.7 ppg – the highest in a single season for her career – and broke the 1,000-point barrier versus Dayton on Dec. 29.

RISING IN THE RANKS: Two players to watch are senior tri-captain Katie Meinhardt and junior tri-captain Cheri Raffo as they make their marks in the school annals.

Meinhardt is currently eighth on BU's all-time scoring list with 1,179 career points, having recently surpassed former teammate Adrienne Norris.

Meinhardt is now two points away from catching up to Laura Boettcher with 1188 points. Her .372 career 3-point percentage is second only to Becky Bonner (.375), while her career scoring average (10.8) is tied ninth.

Meinhardt has excelled behind the charity stripe, garnering a .771 career free throw percentages for fourth place, respectively.

Raffo has not missed a start in three seasons and has logged 2,753 minutes in 90 consecutive appearances.

If she matches her 33.9 minutes per game from 2005-06 by the end of the season the junior will land in 10th place. The junior is 164 minutes from breaking into the top 10 for BU's all-time career minutes played.

Kelly Greenberg enters her third season as the head coach of the Boston University women's basketball program after leading the Terriers to the America East Championship title game in each of her first two campaigns.

A 17-year coaching veteran at the Division I level, Greenberg served as the head coach at the University of Pennsylvania for five seasons before taking over the Terriers' helm in July 2004. Prior to Penn, Greenberg was the top assistant at Holy Cross for seven seasons, including three years as the associate head coach.

Greenberg's teams have claimed seven regular-season conference titles and five conference tournament crowns. She has reached the NCAA Tournament six times as a coach, including twice during her five-year stint at Penn. Since 1993, each of her teams have either finished the regular-season in the top two spots in the league standings or have reached the conference title game.

Last season, Greenberg led her Terrier team to an 18-12 record and an appearance in the America East title game following a thrilling 76-74 overtime victory over second-seeded Stony Brook in the semifinal round.

In her first season at the BU helm, Greenberg's squad posted a 15-16 overall record after making a dramatic run through the America East Tournament. Entering the tournament as the eighth-seeded team,

BU knocked off top-seeded Maine, fourth-seeded Vermont and ninth-seeded Stony Brook en route to becoming the first eighth-seeded team in the tournament's 14-year history to reach the title game. In the finals, BU dropped a 52-50 decision to second-seeded Hartford.

Greenberg was appointed head coach of the BU women's basketball program on July 7, 2004, after guiding Penn to two Ivy League championships during her five-year tenure.

"Boston University is proud to have Kelly Greenberg as our head women's basketball coach," said Director of Athletics Mike Lynch. "She has a proven track record of success at a number of high quality institutions and clearly will help to raise the bar for our team. We look forward to a bright future for our women's basketball program under her leadership."

During her 17 years of coaching at the Division I level as an assistant and head coach and four years as a player, Greenberg boasts a resume that includes 11 conference championships and nine appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

In her five seasons at Penn, Greenberg posted an 84-54 overall record and a 51-19 mark in Ivy League play, finishing no lower than second in the conference each year. Her 84 career wins are the third-highest win total in program history.

In her first season as a head coach in 1999-2000, Greenberg's squad posted its first winning season in eight years. For her efforts, she was named the Philadelphia Big 5 Coach of the Year.

The following season, she guided the Quakers to an Ivy League title as the team went a perfect 14-0 in league games. The team earned the program's first-ever NCAA Tournament bid and posted a school-best 22-6 overall record. During the season, the team won a program-record 21 consecutive games, which ranked as the longest active winning streak in the nation. Following the record-breaking season, Greenberg was honored as the Daily Pennsylvanian Coach of the Year for the second consecutive season.

In 2003-04, Greenberg led the team back to the NCAA Tournament as Penn recorded a 17-10 overall mark and an 11-3 record in Ivy League play.

Prior to her appointment at Penn, Greenberg spent seven seasons on the women's basketball staff at the College of the Holy Cross. During her final four seasons, Greenberg served as the associate head coach under head coach Bill Gibbons. During her tenure, the Crusaders made four trips to the NCAA tournament and captured six Patriot League titles.

Before Holy Cross, Greenberg was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island during the 1991-92 season and The George Washington University in 1990-91. During her tenure at George Washington, the Colonials reached the NCAA tournament, Greenberg's first trip as a coach. She began her coaching career at cross-town rival Northeastern in 1989-90.

An outstanding leader since her collegiate playing days, Greenberg was a two-time Second Team All-Big 5 selection at La Salle University, leading the Explorers to three consecutive Big 5 Championships and three NCAA tournaments in four years. She captained the 1988-89 team to a 28-3 overall record, a national ranking, and a third straight trip to the NCAA tournament. Greenberg graduated in 1989 with a bachelor of arts in English. Greenberg was no stranger to La Salle basketball. Just recently, La Salle honored her family as "La Salle's First Basketball Family." Greenberg's brother, Chip, started all four years at La Salle (1982-86) and is a member of LSU's Hall of Fame. Kelly's father, Hank, captained the 1948-49 team, while her uncle, Charles, was a key member of the 1954 National Championship team.

During her scholastic career, Greenberg excelled at basketball, field hockey and softball at Archbishop Wood High School in Philadelphia. In 2001, she had her No. 32 jersey retired joining two other female athletes, teammate Debbie Black, a WNBA veteran and now an assistant coach at Ohio State, and Kelly's younger sister, Kathy. Kelly is also a member of the high school's alumni hall of fame.




