***Binghamton at New Hampshire, 7 p.m.**

The Bearcats have won three straight and 7-of-10 since starting the year 1-7... Binghamton's Mike Gordon has hit 58.6 percent (17-of-29) of his three-point attempts against America East foes... UNH's Alvin Abreu leads all rookies averaging 13.6 points per game.

***Stony Brook at Hartford, 7 p.m.**
