Friday, January 25

***Vermont at Boston University, 9 p.m. (ESPNU)**

The Catamounts and Terriers square off in the first regular-season conference game to be televised nationally... UVM's Marqus Blakey is second in the league in scoring (18.8 ppg), rebounding (8.6 pg) and is tops with 2.50 blocks per game... Boston U. leads the league in three-point percentage defense, holding opponents to 31.3 percent shooting from deep.

Sunday, January 27

***Binghamton at Maine, 12 noon**

The Bearcats have won four straight and eight of their last 10... Binghamton is holding opponents to 59 points per game during its current win streak... The Black Bears have shot 65 percent (51-of-79) combined in their two league wins.

***Hartford at New Hampshire, 1 p.m.**

The home team took both meetings last season and has won five straight in the series... Hawks' freshman Morgan Sabia is averaging 11.8 points per game in league play and shooting 60 percent from the field against conference foes...
