*UMBC at Vermont, 1 p.m. (PackCast)

The Retrievers and Catamounts enter the contest tied for first in the league standings, along with Binghamton, at 6-2... UMBC defeated Vermont 78-60 earlier this season... The Catamounts have not lost since, reeling off five wins in a row... Marqus Blakely is averaging 18.6 points, 12.6 rebounds and 4.0 blocks per game during the streak... UMBC is second in the country in turnovers per game, giving the ball the away just 9.7 times per contest... The game will be streamed live and be available at AmericaEast.com.

*Hartford at Binghamton, 2 p.m.

Warren McLendon knocked down a pair of free throws in the final seconds to lift the Hawks to an 80-79 victory in the team's first matchup... The Bearcats have won five straight and 9-of-12 overall... They are holding opponents to 59 points per game during the current win streak... The Hawks are averaging 73.5 points per game in league play.
