***Hartford 68, at Albany 61**

The Hawks overcame an 11-point deficit by shooting 57 percent in the second half and outscored the Great Danes 40-30 in the frame... Hartford has won three straight and sits alone in third place in the conference standings... Joe Zeglinski scored 14 of his game-high 19 points in the second half...
