***Stony Brook at Maine, 12 noon**

The Seawolves downed the Black Bears on Jan. 6 to snap an eight-game losing streak against them... Ricky Lucas has scored 20-plus points five times for the SBU... Maine is in search of its first league win at Alfond Arena this season.

Boston University at St. Peter's, 2 p.m.

The Terriers take on the Peacocks in a game that was originally part of the ESPN BracketBusters Pool... John Holland is averaging 18.8 points over his last four games for the Terriers, who have won six of their last seven... St. Peter's, which is 6-20 overall and 3-12 in the MAAC, is 0-1 against America East teams this season, losing to UMBC 81-78 on Nov. 10.

Binghamton at Manhattan, 4 p.m.

The Bearcats take on the Jaspers in a game that was originally part of the ESPN BracketBusters Pool... The Bearcats lead the conference in free throw percentage at 74.1 percent... The Jaspers, who are 11-15 overall and 5-11 in the MAAC, have won three straight contests.

Albany at Canisius, 7 p.m.

The Great Danes take on the Golden Griffins in a game that was originally part of the ESPN BracketBusters Pool... Albany's Brian Lillis is one of 10 players in the country to lead his team in points, rebounds and assists per game... Canisius, which is 4-22 overall and 2-12 in the MAAC, has dropped five straight.

***New Hampshire at UMBC, 7 p.m.**

The Retrievers can clinch their first-ever regular-season league title with a win... A victory would also guarantee a postseason berth to the NIT, should UMBC fall in the America East Championship... UNH's Alvin Abreu leads all conference rookies, averaging 12.5 points per game.

Vermont at UNC Wilmington, 7:30 p.m.

The Catamounts take on the Seahawks in a game that was originally part of the ESPN BracketBusters Pool... Marqus Blakely has double-doubles in nine straight games, a program record... Wilmington, which is 18-10 overall and 11-5 in the CAA, has won five straight.
